



## Maduro declared winner of disputed Venezuela polls

CARACAS

Nicolas Maduro was declared the winner of Venezuela's presidential election on Sunday but the Opposition and key regional neighbours immediately rejected the official results.

The Opposition coalition itself claimed victory, after an election campaign tainted by accusations of political intimidation and fears of fraud, and following predictions by pollsters that Mr. Maduro would lose but was unlikely to concede after more than a decade in power.

He won re-election with 51.2% of votes, while Opposition candidate Edmundo Gonzalez Urrutia received 44.2%, according to the electoral council (CNE), which in its majority is

loyal to the President.

"I can say, before the people of Venezuela and the world, I am Nicolas Maduro Moros, the re-elected President of the Bolivarian Republic of Venezuela," Mr. Maduro said. "There will be peace, stability and justice. Peace and respect for the law."

But the Opposition coalition insisted it had garnered 70% of the vote, rejecting the CNE figures.

#### 'Another fraud'

"We want to say to all of Venezuela and the world that Venezuela has a new president-elect and it is (candidate) Edmundo Gonzalez Urrutia," Opposition leader Maria Corina Machado told journalists, calling the official result "another fraud." Mr. Gonzalez, a 74-year-old former diplomat,





## Defence Acquisition Council approves amendment to MQ-9B UAV deal with U.S.

The Defence Acquisition Council (DAC), chaired by Defence Minister Rajnath Singh, on Monday reviewed and approved amendments to the deal for procuring 31 MO-9B High Altitude Long Endurance (HALE) Unmanned Aerial Vehicles (UAV) from General Atomics of the U.S., defence sources said. The DAC also gave approval to a proposal regarding the scheduled refit of aircraft carrier INS Vikramaditya later this year, sources said.

"The amendments approved are within the scope of the Acceptance of Necessity (AoN) that was granted for the MQ-9B

With the Quad leaders summit scheduled to be hosted by India in December, the MQ-9B deal and the GE-414 jet engine deal are expected to be concluded during the visit of the U.S. President to India.

India is looking to procure 31 MQ-9B UAVs –15 Sea Guardians for the Indian Navy and 16 Sky Guardians (eight each for the Indian Army and Air Force) – at an estimated cost of \$3.99 billion. As part of the deal, General Atomics is scheduled to establish a Global Maintenance, Repair and Overhaul (MRO) facility in India which would count towards offset obligations.

The DAC also accorded AoN, the first step of the procurement process, for procurement of Advanced Land Navigation System (ALNS) for Armoured Fighting Vehicles (AFVs) of the Army and 22 Interceptor Boats for the Coast Guard.

The ALNS Mk-II offers compatibility with defence series maps resulting in very high accuracy in navigational applications for AFVs. This equipment will be procured from Bharat Electronics Limited.

The second AoN is for procurement of 22 Interceptor Boats for the Coast Guard with latest state-of-art system capable of quick interception and shallow water operation in territorial waters, the Ministry said. "These boats will be used for coastal surveillance and patrolling, search & rescue operations, including medical evacuation," it added.





- The Karnataka High Court has recently quashed proceedings under the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012 against a 23-year-old man accused of raping a minor, who he subsequently married.
- This decision includes a caveat allowing the criminal proceedings to be revived if the man abandons his wife and child in the future.
- This condition is aimed at ensuring the welfare and protection of the mother and child.

- How did the Court Justify the Quashing of the Case?
- Accused's Counsel: Argued that the accused and the victim were in love and the crime was registered after the parents agreed to the marriage. Highlighted that both families had come forward to support the marriage.
- State's Counsel: Argued that the case should not be quashed due to the heinous nature of the offence, which is punishable by ten years in prison. Emphasised the importance of taking the matter to trial.

Court's Decision: Protection of the Victim and Child: The court emphasised that releasing the petitioner without resolving the issue would leave the mother and child vulnerable, facing societal ignominy and potential jeopardy.

Victim's Potential Hostility: The court noted that the victim would likely turn hostile, making the conviction of the petitioner highly unlikely.

What is the Protection of Children from Sexual Offences (POCSO) Act, 2012? About:

The Protection of Children from Sexual Offences Act, 2012 (POCSO Act, 2012) was enacted to protect children from sexual abuse, filling a significant legislative gap in India despite the United Nations' adoption of the Convention on the Rights of the Child in 1989.

• This Act imposes severe penalties, including **up to 20 years of imprisonment** and the death penalty for aggravated penetrative sexual assault.

- Shortcomings of the POCSO Act:Application of Last Seen Theory:
- The Supreme Court in Anjan Kumar Sarma v. State of Assam, 2017 ruled that this theory is weak without corroborative evidence, risking wrongful convictions.
  - This theory states that if someone is the last person seen with the
    victim before a crime and cannot provide a credible explanation, there
    is a strong presumption that they are responsible for the crime.

**Consensual Sexual Activities:** The Act prosecutes a **non-minor partner in consensual sex with a minor,** as minors' consent is deemed irrelevant.

**False Complaints by Children**: Section 22 exempts children from punishment for false complaints, leading to potential misuse.

**Two-Finger Test:** Despite being banned in 2012, this test is still conducted, violating the victim's privacy and dignity, as noted in *Lillu @ Rajesh v. State of Haryana*, 2013.




# Australia Banned Uranium Mining at Jabiluka site

 Australia Banned Uranium Mining at Jabiluka site, which is home to one of the world's largest deposits of high-grade uranium.

#### About

- The Jabiluka site is surrounded by Kakadu National Park.
- Archaeologists discovered a buried trove of stone axes and tools near the Jabiluka site in 2017, which they dated at tens of thousands of years old.

• The Jabiluka site became the focus of intense legal wrangling between the **Mirarr people** and mining companies after the uranium deposit was discovered there in the early 1970s.





- Recently, the UNESCO tag for Tell Umm
   Amer heritage site in Gaza was announced during the ongoing 46th session of the World Heritage Committee at New Delhi.
- About Tell Umm Amer (aka Saint Hilarion Monastery)
- It stands and nestled amidst the **coastal dunes in Nuseirat Municipality, Palestine,** this remarkable site dates back to the 4th century as a testament to centuries of devotion and cultural exchange.





The monastery owes its existence to **Saint Hilarion**, a visionary ascetic who sought solitude in the wilderness.



Initially, it served as a haven for solitary hermits, but over time, it evolved into a vibrant coenobitic community—a place where monks lived together, sharing their spiritual journeys.

# Proposal by PARAKH on student assessment

 The Performance Assessment Review and Analysis of Knowledge for Holistic Development (PARAKH) suggested to Include Class 9-11 performance for Class 12 results

#### About PARAKH

 National Assessment Centre- PARAKH was set up in NCERT as an independent constituent unit in 2023, to fulfil the basic objectives of setting norms, standards, guidelines and implement activities related to student assessment along with other tasks as mandated by the National Education Policy (NEP) 2020.

- There are four major areas of focus for PARAKH:
- Capacity Development in Competency Based Assessment
- Large-Scale Achievement Survey
- Equivalence of School Boards
- Holistic Progress Cards for the Foundational, Preparational, Middle and Secondary Stages.

- Recent Recommendations
- Integration of Performance: Performance from Classes 9, 10, and 11 should be included in the final Class 12 report card, with weighted contributions of 15% from Class 9, 20% from Class 10, 25% from Class 11, and 40% from Class 12.
- **Assessment Types:** Class 9: 70% formative assessments, 30% summative assessments.
  - Class 10: 50% formative assessments, 50% summative assessments.
  - Class 11: 40% formative assessments, 60% summative assessments.
  - Class 12: 30% formative assessments, 70% summative assessments.

- Holistic Progress Card: Includes self-evaluation, teacher assessments of group work, and peer feedback.
- Credit System: Classes 9 and 10: 40 credits each.
  - Classes 11 and 12: 44 credits each.
  - Subject-specific credits include 32 for Classes 9 and 10 (e.g., 12 for languages, 4 each for mathematics, science, social science).
- National Credit Framework: Boards are recommended to develop a credit transfer system aligned with the National Credit Framework.

July 26 is International Day for Conservation of Mangrove Ecosystems, declared by UNESCO to raise awareness and promote sustainable management of mangroves, vital for coastal protection, storm mitigation, and carbon sequestration.



<u>Celebrated annually on July 26</u>, this day aims to raise awareness about the importance of mangrove ecosystems and promote sustainable management and conservation solutions. It was established by <u>UNESCO</u> in 2015.

- Mangroves in India The 'State of World Mangroves 2022' report by the Global Mangrove Alliance puts the total mangrove cover of the world at 1,47,000 sq km (14.7 million hectares).
- Mangroves make up only about 0.15% of India's land area but provide numerous benefits to coastal communities over its vast coastline (spanning 7516km)

Mangroves in India are distributed across nine States and three Union Territories with West Bengal having the highest mangrove cover of 2,114 sq km.

The IFSR report also points out that there has been an increase in the mangrove cover from 4,046 sq km in 1987 to 4,992 sq km in 2021.

However, the <u>National Decadal Wetland Change Atlas (2022)</u> indicates a decline in natural coastal wetlands, with intertidal mudflats and salt marshes reducing significantly.



Mangrove Ecosystem Benefits



Water Filteration | 2 to 5 Hectares of Mangroves may treat the effulents of 1 hectare of aquaculture



Fisheries | More than 3000 fish species are found in mangrove ecosystems



Climate Regulation | Carbon stroage potential of mangroves is 3-5X higher than that of tropical upland forest



Livelihoods | 120 million people live near mangroves



Wood | Its density makes mangrove wood a valued source of timber and fuel



Coastal Protection | Mangroves are 5 times more cost effective than grey infrastructure.



Mangrove Ecosystem Serivces | Worth US\$ 33,000 to 57,000 per hectare per year x 14 million hectares i.e. 800\$ / year



Tourism | There are over 2000 mangrove related attractions globally, such as boat tours, boardwalks, kayaking & fishing.
