The Civil Registration System (CRS), the Union government's centralised portal to register births and deaths, has been facing glitches for the past four months, several State government officials have told The Hindu. The malfunction has led to delays in issuing birth and death registration certificates.

Egg or sperm donor has no legal right on child: Bombay HC

Court allows woman to visit her twin daughters born through surrogacy; her sister had claimed she was the biological parent as she was the donor

<u>Purnima Sah</u> MUMBAI

he Bombay High Court on Tuesday held that merely donating eggs or sperm does not give legal entitlement to the donor to claim that he or she is the biological parent of the child.

Pronouncing the verdict that was reserved on August 2, a single-judge Bench of Justice Milind Jadhav dismissed the argument of a woman (petitioner's sister) who had volunteered to donate her oocyte (eggs) to her sister and brother-in-law who could not conceive naturally, and said the sister had no legitimate right to claim that she was the biological parent of the twins. The Bench was hearing

a plea filed by a woman (petitioner) who challenged a trial court order that refused to give her visitation rights and access to her twin daughters born through surrogacy. Appearing for the peti-

Appearing for the petitioner, advocate Ganesh Gole argued that since the twin girls are of growing age, the petitioner needs to The Bench was hearing a plea challenging a trial court order that refused visitation rights.

be given visitation rights. "When the petitioner failed to conceive naturally, the couple consulted a gynaecologist who advised them to go for altruistic surrogacy through an egg donor and that is when the petitioner approached her younger sister." the advocate said.

Later, the husband left the petitioner, took away the twins, and started living with the sister.

2005 guidelines The judge referred to the

National Guidelines for Accreditation, Supervision and Regulation of ART (Assisted Reproductive Technology) Clinics in India, enacted in 2005, and not-

ed, "The vounger sister of petitioner can have no right whatsoever to intervene and claim to be the biological mother of the twin daughters as argued. The submissions on behalf of the husband that his wife's vounger sister being the oocyte donor is the biological mother stands rejected outrightly in view of the settled position in law on the basis of the guidelines and the Surrogacy Act enacted subsequently. The limited role of the younger sister of petitioner is that of an oocyte donor, rather a voluntary donor and at the highest, she may qualify to be a genetic mother and nothing more, but by such qualification, she would have no intending legal right whatsoever to claim to be the biological mother of the twin daughters as

the law clearly does not recognise so." Justice Jadhav held that the lower court order that denied visitation rights to the petitioner was without proper application of mind. The court granted the petitioner visitation rights and access to the twin daughters.

• Bombay High Court Ruling on Egg or Sperm Donors

- The Bombay High Court ruled that donating eggs or sperm does not give the donor any legal right to claim biological parenthood of the child.
- The court dismissed the argument of a woman who donated eggs to her sister, claiming to be the biological mother of the twins born through surrogacy.

Case Background

- The petitioner, who had donated her eggs to her sister and brotherin-law, filed a plea for visitation rights to her twin daughters born through surrogacy.
- The twins were taken by the husband, and the petitioner sought legal recognition as their biological mother.

Legal Considerations

- The court referred to the 2005 National Guidelines for Accreditation, Supervision, and Regulation of ART (Assisted Reproductive Technology) Clinics in India.
- The guidelines and subsequent Surrogacy Act do not recognize egg or sperm donors as biological parents.
- The court emphasized that the donor's role is limited to being an oocyte (egg) donor and does not confer any legal rights to claim parenthood.

1.Court's Decision

- 1. The court rejected the petitioner's claim to be the biological mother based on the settled legal position.
- 2. The lower court had earlier denied visitation rights to the petitioner based on a misinterpretation of the law.

Starbucks CEO Narasimhan steps down, Chipotle's Niccol to take over

STARBUCKS NAMED Chipotle Mexican Grill head Brian Niccol as its new CEO on Tuesday in a management shakeup as it tries to fend off pressures from activist investor Elliott Investment Management.

Niccol replaces Laxman Narasimhan, who officially took over as CEO in April last year and was poached from Lysol maker Reckitt to undertake a "reinvention" of the world's biggest coffee chain.

But Starbucks stock has continued to suffer, losing roughly 20 per cent of its value over the last five years when the broadmarket S&P 500 has gained more than 80 per cent. In July, the company fell short of sales expectations due to weakening demand in the United States and China.

Starbucks stock was up 21 per cent in early trading on Tuesday and on track for its best day ever, erasing all of the losses for the year. Chipotle's shares were down 9 per cent.

Elliott, which owns a sizable stake, has been pressuring the

company to improve its performance and stock price, proposing Starbucks expand its board and improve governance. Elliott's offer was reported to be part of an effort to allow Narasimhan to keep his job as CEO. When asked on CNBC if activist Elliott was consulted about the shakeup, Starbucks Board Chair Mellody Hobson said it had not been.

"We look forward to engaging with all of our shareholders about this new development," she said.

It is unclear what will happen with negotiations with Elliott. Elliott Management did not respond to Reuters' request for comment. The activist hedge fund was seeking to add Jesse Cohn, an equity and managing partner in the firm, to the Starbucks board, Reuters reported Monday, citing sources.

In May, days after Starbucks cut its annual sales forecast, former CEO Howard Schultz wrote on his LinkedIn account that its U.S. operations were the "primary reason for its fall from grace," and that senior leaders need to spend more time with workers.

Niccol inherits several chal-

lenges at the coffee giant, which recently tweaked its model to focus on mobile pickup and delivery orders rather than cafes set up for long visits. In China, Starbucks has encountered competition from rivals discounting coffee prices, while its cafes in the Middle East have been subject to some pro-Palestinian boycotts amid the Israel-Hamas conflict.

"(Niccol is) going to turn the company around. It will be a little bit of a heavy lift for the first few quarters, but Niccol (has) proven what he can do at Chipotle," said Thomas Hayes, chairman at Great Hill Capital.

"This guy is a fixer and a doer and an executor," Hayes said.

Niccol joined Chipotle in 2018 from Taco Bell and has seen the company's annual sales more than double to nearly \$10 billion. In its most recent quarter, quarterly results topped Wall Street estimates on strong demand. Starbucks said Niccol will start in his new role on Sept. 9 and that CFO Rachel Ruggeri will serve as interim CEO until that time. Chipotle said its board had appointed Scott Boatwright, chief operating officer, as interim CEO.

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Starbucks CEO Transition

Starbucks announced that Laxman Narasimhan is stepping down as CEO.

Brian Niccol, former head of Chipotle Mexican Grill, has been named as the new CEO.

Narasimhan took over as CEO in April of the previous year and was previously with Lysol maker Reckitt.

- Challenges Faced by Starbucks
- Starbucks has struggled with declining stock value, losing roughly 20% over the last five years.
- The broader market S&P 500 gained more than 80% during the same period.
- The decline is attributed to weakening demand in the United States and China.
- In China, Starbucks faces competition from rivals offering discounted coffee prices, while in the Middle East, its cafes have been subject to boycotts related to the Israel-Hamas conflict.

• Role of Elliott Investment Management

- Elliott Investment Management, an activist investor with a sizable stake in Starbucks, influenced the management shakeup.
- Elliott had earlier proposed expanding Starbucks's international presence and improving governance.
- Reports suggest that Elliott might have allowed Narasimhan to remain as CEO if specific conditions were met.

- Brian Niccol's Background and Expectations
- Niccol, who joined Chipotle in 2018 from Taco Bell, significantly boosted Chipotle's sales, reaching nearly \$10 billion annually.
- He is known as a "fixer and a doer," expected to bring the same energy to Starbucks.
- Starbucks has adjusted its model to focus more on mobile pickup and delivery, a strategy that Niccol might continue to refine.

AMONG THE countries with a doubledigit gold medal haul, New Zealand, with a population of just over 5.3 million, was the smallest. It finished 11th on the medal table with 10 gold and 20 overall, improving from 7 and 20 in Tokyo. Canoe Sprint and track cycling brought them multiple gold, in addition to men's high jump, canoe slalom, golf, rowing and rugby sevens. Of the top 10 finishers, South Korea sent just 144 competitors in 23 sports. And won a staggering 32 medals. That's a medal: participation ratio of 1:5. All other Top 10s, sent over 300 athletes. Austria finished 36th on the medal table with two gold medals. Nothing

What are the Key Outcomes of the Visit?

Water and Sewerage Network:

Mr Jaishankar and the Maldivian Foreign Minister jointly inaugurated India's Line of Credit (LoC) assisted project of water and sewerage network in 28 islands of Maldives.

Capacity Building:

A memorandum of Understanding on capacity building of additional 1,000 Maldivian civil servants in India was signed.

- Launch of UPI:
- Both countries agreed to the introduction of UPI in Maldives.
- Community Development Projects:
- Six High Impact Community Development Projects (HICDPs) under grant assistance by India in the areas of mental health, special education, speech therapy and street lighting were jointly inaugurated.

- 'Ek Ped Maa ke Naam' Initiative:
- Indian EAM planted a sapling at the Lonuziyaaraiy Park as part of Prime Minister Modi's 'Ek Ped Maa ke Naam' initiative and President Muizzu's 5 Million Tree Project.

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- Greater Male Connectivity Project:
- EAM visited the India-assisted Greater Male Connectivity Project (GMCP) site and announced India's commitment to the progress of this flagship development project.

- Infrastructure and Development Projects: The handover of water supply and sewerage facilities on 28 islands in the Maldives, funded by India, demonstrates India's ongoing support for the country's development.
 - These projects enhance the local economy and highlight India's role in the Maldives' prosperity, marking key milestones in their bilateral relationship.

- Training 1000 Maldivian Civil Service Officers
- India and Maldives renewed the MoU for the capacity building of 1000 Maldives civil services officers during the period 2024-2029.

• Security Provider:

- India has a history of providing security assistance, intervening during a coup attempt in 1988 through Operation Cactus and conducting joint naval exercises for the protection of the Maldives.
- Joint Exercises include "Ekuverin", "Dosti" and "Ekatha".

UNESCO Kalinga Prize for Popularisation of Science

The Ministry of Science and Technology (DST) has withdrawn its annual contribution to the UNESCO Kalinga Prize.

Former Odisha Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik has protested the withdrawal and requested the restoration of support.

• About the UNESCO Kalinga Prize for Popularisation of Science

- It was established in **1951** following a donation from Mr. Bijoyanand Patnaik, Founder and President of the Kalinga Foundation Trust.
- It is UNESCO's oldest prize.
- The prize winner is selected by UNESCO's Director-General on the recommendation of a five-member jury.

The award is presented during the World Science Day celebrations in Budapest, alternating with India.

Eligibility: Individuals, institutions, NGOs, or entities making significant contributions to science and technology communication.

Donors: Kalinga Foundation Trust, Government of the State of Orissa, Government of India (Department of Science and Technology).

Award: Cash prize of US\$40,000 and a Kalinga Chair with an additional US\$5,000,UNESCO-Albert Einstein silver medal.

World's oldest calendar discovered in Turkey

 Archaeologists at Göbekli Tepe, an ancient site in Turkey, have possibly discovered the world's oldest calendar, dating back nearly 13,000 years.

• About

- Göbekli Tepe, often referred to as the world's first temple, features a series of large stone pillars adorned with ornate carvings.
- These carvings have long puzzled researchers, but recent studies suggest they represent an ancient timekeeping system.



The carvings on the pillars include a series of V-shaped symbols, each representing a single day. By counting these symbols, researchers identified a calendar of 365 days, divided into 12 lunar months with an additional 11 days.



This system aligns closely with the modern solar calendar, indicating a sophisticated understanding of astronomy by the ancient people who created it long before the development of written language.

Nagaland's DRTPS Initiative





Nagaland became the <u>first state in India to adopt a Disaster Risk</u> <u>Transfer Parametric Insurance Solution (DRTPS)</u> by signing an MoU with SBI General Insurance.



The insurance aims to protect critical infrastructure and reduce economic losses from extreme weather events over a <u>three-year</u> <u>period (2024-2027).</u>



Parametric insurance provides a predefined payout when specific events, like **<u>natural disasters</u>**, occur, ensuring quick financial support and enhancing the **<u>state's resilience</u>**.

The significance of this initiative lies in its **ability to enhance Nagaland's financial resilience** and safeguard livelihoods against the increasing frequency of extreme weather events

. Providing <u>quick payouts after</u> <u>disasters</u> helps ensure rapid recovery and reduces economic losses, setting a precedent for disaster risk management in India.

Grain ATM



The WFP and the Government of Odisha launched India's first 24/7 'Grain ATM,' called 'Annapurti,' in Bhubaneswar.



This initiative <u>allows Public Distribution System beneficiaries to access food grains</u> <u>anytime under the National Food Security Act</u>. The machine, which can dispense up to <u>50 kilograms of grain in five minutes</u> after biometric authentication, reduces waiting times by 70% and can be powered by solar panels.



This partnership aims to enhance food security across Odisha, providing consistent access to essential grains for all beneficiaries.
