

Submarine Arighaat set to add ballast to nuclear triad

It is India's second nuclear-powered ballistic missile submarine; 'technological advancements undertaken indigenously make it significantly more advanced than its predecessor, *Arihant*'

ndia's second nuclearpowered ballistic missile submarine, *INS Arighaat*, was commissioned into service at Visakhapatnam in the presence of Defence Minister Rajnath Singh on Thursday. It joins the first such submarine, *INS Arihant*, which was commissioned in 2016.

"The Arighaat will further strengthen India's nuclear triad, enhance nuclear deterrence, establish strategic balance and peace and play a decisive role in the country's security," Mr. Singh said at the induction ceremony.

The technological advancements undertaken indigenously on this submarine make it significantly more advanced than its predecessor, *Arihant*, the Defence Ministry said in a statement. The presence of both *INS Arihant* and *INS Arighaat* will enhance India's capability to deter potential adversaries and safeguard its national interests, it added.

As reported earlier by *The Hindu, INS Arihant* was

quietly commissioned into service in August 2016. It has a displacement of 6,000 tonnes and is powered by an 83-MW pressurised light-water reactor with enriched uranium. *INS Arighaat* retains the same reactor and dimensions, but has several technological upgrades.

"It has the distinction of having the indigenous systems and equipment which were conceptualised, designed, manufactured and integrated by Indian scientists, industry and Naval personnel," the Ministry statement said. Nuclear deterrence

INS Arihant is armed with a 750-km-range K-15 Submarine Launched Ballistic Missile (SLBM), while a 3,500-km-range SLBM K-4 is under development, having been tested for the first time in 2020. The K4 will become the mainstay of India's undersea nuclear deterrence, as it gives the stand-off capability to launch nuclear weapons while submerged in Indian waters.

Pakistan invites Modi to attend the SCO meet in Islamabad

Pakistan on Thursday invited Prime Minister Narendra Modi to the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation's Council of Heads of Government meeting to be held here in October.

Pakistan holds the rotating chairmanship of the SCO Council of Heads of Government and in that capacity, will be hosting the two-day in-person SCO Heads of Governments Meeting in October.

"Invitations have been sent to the heads of countries to participate in the meeting which will take place on October 15-16. An invitation has also been sent to the Prime Minister of India Narendra ," Foreign Office Spokesperson Mumtaz Zahra Baloch told a press briefing.

Some countries have confirmed participation, which will be informed to the public soon, she said.

When asked about ties with India, the spokesperson said: "Pakistan does not have direct bilateral trade with India." The Islamabad summit meeting will be preceded by a Ministerial meeting and several rounds of senior officials' meetings focused on financial, economic, sociocultural, and humanitarian cooperation among the

SCO member States. The SCO, comprising India, China, Russia, Pakistan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Tajikistan and Uzbekistan, is an influential economic and security bloc that has emerged as one of the largest trans-regional international organisations.


The story so far: ormen-led development remains at the core of announcements made by the Finance Minister (FM) in this year's Budget. What is the reason for the increase? The GBS, since it was first introduced in 2005-06, consistently reported an average share of 5% of the total budgetary allocations, with marginal ups and downs. This year is special as the share of allocations to one women schemes stands allocations to pro-women schemes stands at approximately 6.8% of the total budget expenditure for 2024-25, which is way above the usual trends and marks a positive departure from status quo. The increase in GB allocations are

driven by two factors. A part of this increase has been on account of the newly included Part 'C,' a third part in the GBS that reports pro-women schemes with less than 30% provisioning for women. The PM Kisan scheme in the reported under part A thus driving the up allocations. Such reporting of PMAY may not be entirely accurate as not all agriculture sector has been reported in part C with an outlay of \$15,000 crore. These anomalies can be minimised by incorporating explanations for the entries made in the GBS. Incorporating explanations for allocations in GBs would will help in gender audits and provide pathways for improved gender outcomes in government programmes. The above anomalies in reporting are reflections of the GBS still not having a scientific and systematic approach. Efforts to reduce misreporting and improve the quality of the GBS is evident, but there is still a long way to go. The need for including rationale is also to maintain that detailed reporting is not a mere exercise in increasing the quantum of allocations reported for women's development - it is to ensure actual spending for women in all government programmes, that are well planned and designed to include women's needs from its inception. 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



Capital support for raw materials, but lower subsidy for assembling plants

SOUMYARENDRA BARIK New Delhi, August 29

AFTER HAVING COMMITTED nearly all of the \$10 billion in subsidies under its ambitious semiconductor manufacturing incentive policy, the government has prepared a blueprint for the second phase of the scheme — it could increase the outlay of the programme to \$15 billion, offer capital support for raw materials and gases used in chip manufacturing, and reduce subsidies for assembly and testing plants, it has been learnt.

"In a short period of time, we managed to clear four chip proposals, including a fabrication plant. The original incentive policy outlay of \$10 billion will almost get over once subsidy payments are made to the entities setting up these facilities.

pegged that the new 2.0 scheme should have a higher outlay of \$15 billion so that we can remain competitive, given that many countries are trying to attract chip manufacturing," a senior government official said, requesting anonymity.

The IT ministry didn't respond to a request for comment.

India has ambitions to become a major chip hub on the lines of the US, Taiwan and South Korea, and has been courting foreign companies to set up operations in the country. So far, the country has

> approved a fabrication plant worth \$11 billion being set up by Tata Electronics in partnership with Taiwan's Powerchip, and three different chip assembly plants being set up by the Tatas, US-based Micron Technology, and Murugappa Group's CG Power in partnership with Japan's Renesas.

In an internal note prepared with the projections for the renewal of the scheme, the government has also decided to reduce the capex subsidy for assembly and testing plants (ATMP/OSAT) from the current

50% to 30% for conventional packaging technologies, and 40% for advanced packaging technologies.

In the first iteration of the incentive policy, which was released in December 2021, the Centre had offered a 30% capex subsidy for chip packaging and testing plants. However, in September 2022, it had increased the subsidy for such plants to 50%. It is understood that it was done as a precursor to Micron's proposal, as the government wanted to facilitate the company establishing an assembly plant in India, which was eventually approved in June 2023.

Now though, the government wants to go back to its earlier subsidy contribution, there is a growing perception within sections of the administration that it has overspent on packaging and assembly plants.

The Centre also does not want to support tech transfer costs under the new scheme, it is understood. This means that companies partnering with others for using their chip manufacturing technology may have to pay out of their own pocket.



Increased Outlay for Semiconductor Manufacturing:

The Indian government has prepared a blueprint for the second phase of its semiconductor manufacturing incentive scheme, increasing the outlay to \$15 billion from the original \$10 billion.

The goal is to provide capital support for raw materials and gases used in chip manufacturing, as well as to reduce subsidies for assembling and testing plants.

• Ambitious Goals:

- India aims to become a major hub for chip manufacturing, competing with countries like the US, Taiwan, and South Korea.
- The government has been courting foreign companies to set up operations in India, with several already approved to set up plants.

• Approved Projects:

- So far, India has approved an \$11-billion fabrication plant by Tata Electronics in partnership with Taiwan's Powerchip.
- Three chip assembly units have been cleared, set up by the Tatas, USbased Micron Technology, and Murugappa Group's CG Power in partnership with Japan's Renesas.

Subsidy Adjustments:

The government is considering reducing the capex subsidy for chip packaging and testing plants from the current 50% to 30% for conventional packaging technologies and 40% for advanced packaging technologies.

The initial policy released in December 2021 offered a 30% capex subsidy, which was later increased to 50% in September 2022 to attract more investments.

• Strategic Approach:

- The government does not plan to support tech transfer costs under the new scheme, implying that companies partnering with others to enhance their chip manufacturing technology will have to bear these costs themselves.
- Focus on Self-Reliance:
- The Centre's approach emphasizes boosting domestic capabilities in semiconductor manufacturing to reduce reliance on imports and position India as a competitive player in the global chip industry.







Oral cholera vaccine

- Bharat Biotech launched Hillchol (BBV131), an oral cholera vaccine developed in partnership with Hilleman Labs.
- This vaccine addresses the **global shortage of Oral Cholera Vaccines** (OCVs), with demand exceeding 100 million doses annually.
- The vaccine is a two-dose oral treatment, <u>aiming to combat cholera</u> <u>globally. Phase I and II trials were conducted in Bangladesh, and</u> <u>Phase III in India</u>.

• **Cholera** is an acute, diarrheal disease caused by the bacterium *Vibrio cholerae*. It is characterized by severe diarrhea and dehydration, which can lead to rapid and life-threatening fluid loss if not treated promptly.



Codon deoptimization technology

- Indian Immunologicals Ltd (IIL), in collaboration with Griffith University, Australia, has developed a <u>needle-free intranasal COVID-</u> 19 booster vaccine using codon deoptimization technology.
- This <u>live-attenuated vaccine, which modulates viral attenuation by</u> adjusting genetic codons, is designed to be safe and quick to produce.

Perpetual bond

- : Canara Bank issued India's first Additional Tier I perpetual bonds since recent rule changes, attracting strong investor interest with a lower-than-expected coupon of 8.27%.
- This marks a revival in demand for these bonds, which had declined due to regulatory challenges.
- The Securities and Exchange Board of India's (SEBI) recent valuation tweak, allowing mutual funds to value these bonds based on the call option, has made them more attractive.

 A perpetual bond is a type of <u>debt security that does not have a</u> <u>fixed maturity date</u>. Unlike traditional bonds that have a <u>set date</u> <u>when the principal amount is repaid, perpetual bonds continue to</u> <u>pay interest indefinitely.</u>

National Medical Register Portal

- The Union Minister for Health, launched the <u>National Medical</u> <u>Register (NMR) Portal, a comprehensive digital database for all</u> <u>registered allopathic (MBBS) doctors in India.</u>
- The National Medical Register (NMR) is mandated under Section 31 of the National Medical Commission (NMC) Act, 2019.
- It requires the <u>Ethics & Medical Registration Board (EMRB) of</u> <u>NMC</u> to maintain an <u>electronic registry of licensed medical</u> <u>practitioners</u>, including <u>their names, addresses, and qualifications.</u>

- The NMR will be <u>linked with doctors'</u> <u>Aadhaar ID</u>s to verify authenticity and facilitate the verification process among State Medical Councils (SMCs).
- Its significance includes <u>strengthening</u> <u>the digital healthcare ecosystem</u>, <u>ensuring transparent access to</u> <u>quality medical professionals, and</u> <u>consolidating public trust in</u> <u>healthcare</u>.



Discount on New Vehicles Against Scrapping Certificates

Auto manufacturers have agreed to offer discounts on commercial and passenger vehicles against a scrappage certificate of an old vehicle for a limited period of time.


This scrappage discount will replace the discount customers were getting for exchanging their vehicles from car dealers.

Scrappage Terms:

Commercial vehicle (CV) manufacturers are willing to offer discounts for a limited period of two years and passenger vehicle (PV) manufacturers are willing to offer discounts for one year against a Certificate of Deposit (Scrappage Certificate).

Discount by State Governments: State governments have taken a big interest in scrappage policy. Many States which are offering 25-30% discount on road tax for recycled cars.

- Categorisation of Vehicles for the Scrappage Policy:
- The rules applied to scrap these vehicles shall vary depending on the **categorisation** of the vehicles
- Private vehicles: All private cars must undergo a fitness test after 15 years of their registration. If the car clears the fitness test, renewal of registration can be done which is valid for 5 years.
- Commercial vehicles: Commercial vehicles, like buses, trucks, etc., are eligible for fitness tests every two years for the first 8 years of registration and every one year after 8 years till the registration age of the vehicle reaches 15 years.
