





Bills get short shrift in both LS and RS

During the five-year term of the 17th Lok Sabha that ended in 2024, only 9.08 hours were spent on Priv-ate Members' Bills, while the Rajya Sabha spent 27.01 hours on them during the period, shows an analysis by PRS Legislative Re-search, an independent re-search body. The Lower House spent

16.43 hours and the Upper House 20.78 hours on Private Members' Resolution In the two sessions of the 18th Lok Sabha, 0.15 hours was spent on such Bills, while the Raiva Sabha spent 0.62 hours in this pe-riod. The Lower House spent I.98 hours on resolu-

spent 1.98 hours on resolu-tions and the Upper House 2.09 hours.

The resolutions are de-clarations on which the House votes, while the Bills refer to proposed legisla-tion. These are the only instruments available for MPs' individual expression without being bound by their party's diktat.

Political messaging They serve as an important medium for political mes-

The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) successfully launched the Space Docking Experiment (SpaDeX) mission on Monday.

The PSLV C60 rocket carrying two small satellites, SDX01 (Chaser) and SDX02 (Target), along with 24 payloads, lifted off from the first launchpad of the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in Sriharikota at 10 p.m.

About 15 minutes after lift-off, the two small spacecraft weighing about 220 kg each were launched into a 475-km circular orbit as intended.

"The rocket has placed the satellites in the right orbit which is into a 475-km circular orbit. The spacecraft's solar panels have been deployed successfully. The two SpaDeX satellites have moved one behind another so over a period of time it will pick up further distance; the distance will increase by 20 km over the next few days and then the rendezvous and docking process will start. The docking process can happen in another one week; the nominal time will be approximately January 7," said ISRO Chairman S. Somanth.

Technology for future

With the SpaDeX mission, the ISRO aims at exhibiting technologies needed for spacecraft rendezvous, docking, and undocking using two small satellites which have been mastered by only an elite group of spacefaring nations.

The demonstration of this technology is essential for futuristic missions, including sending an Indian astronaut to the moon, sample return from the moon, and the building and operation of an Indian space station.

ISRO said that the demonstrated precision of the PSLV vehicle would be utilised to give a small relative velocity between the Target and Chaser spacecraft at the time of separation from the launch vehicle.

"This incremental velocity will allow the Target spacecraft to build a 10-20 km inter-satellite separation with respect to the Chaser within a day. At this point, the relative velocity between the Target will be compensated using the propulsion system of the Target spacecraft," ISRO said.

ISRO added that at the end of this drift arrest manoeuvre, Target and Chaser will be in the same orbit with identical velocity but separated by about 20 km, known as Far Rendezvous.

Behaviour that causes mental pain to spouse ground for divorce: SC

The Supreme Court has in a judgment held that pat-terns of behaviour which cause immense emotional cause immense emotional distress to a spouse amount to mental cruelty and is a ground for divorce. A Bench headed by Justice Vikram Nath said cruelty was not limited to inflicting

was not limited to inflicting physical pain to a spouse.

"Cruelty also encome the property of the property of

the prolonged legal battle between a couple, both en-gineers with a child, who have lived separately for the couple of the couple of the divorce on the ground that this estranged wife's con-duct, including leaving the matrimonial home and fil-ing criminal complaints against him, amounted to against fairs, amounted to mental cruelty. He said her behaviour had not only strained their relationship but also caused significant damage to his reputation and peace of mind. The Madras High Court had gi-

ven the man divorce. She challenged the decree in the Supreme Court. Upholding the High Court decision, the Bench agreed that "sustained emotional torment and loss of trust in the marital relationship constitutes cruelty". The court said cruelty included actions of iust isolated incidents but just isolated incidents but formed a pattern of beha-viour that made cohabita-tion impossible. Sustained and deliberate acts of crusely make it unreasona-ble to expect a spouse to continue living with the other, Justice Nath noted. "Marriage is a relation-ship built on mutual trust, companionship. and

companionship, and shared experiences. When these essential elements are missing for an extend ed period, the marital bond becomes a mere legal formality devoid of any



The UK will end a tax exemption for private schools on Wednesday, the centre-left Labour government has announced, in a move set to raise over £1.5 billion for public education.

After years of worsening educational inequalities, from January 1, private schools will have to pay 20% value added tax on tuition fees, which will be used to fund thousands of new teachers and improve standards in state schools.

"It's time things are done differently", finance minister Rachel Reeves said. The funding will "go towards our state schools where 94% of children are educated", she said. The policy was promised by Labour in its election campaign and laid out in its inaugural budget in October. It hopes the move will bring in £1.5 billion for the 2025/2026 school year and rise to £1.7 billion a year by 2029/2030, which will be used to fund 6,500 new teachers in the public sector.

Tuition fees in private schools already average £18,000 a year, according to the Independent Schools Council, which represents private schools. That figure is set to rise, with the government estimating that tuition fees will increase by around 10%, with schools taking on part of the additional cost.

Opponents of the reform say state school enrolment will explode if the private sector is lost, increasing the cost to the government. But studies contradict this. The Institute for Fiscal Studies calculated that the number of children in state schools will actually fall by 2030 due to a projected population decline. Several research centres also point out that the disparity between private and state schools widened sharply under the 14-year Conservative rule.

'World population will be 8.09bn on New Year's Day; 71m spike in 2024'

New York: The world population increased by more than 71 million people in 2024 and will be 8.09 billion people on New Year's Day, according to US Census Bureau estimates released Monday. The 0.9% increase in 2024 was a slight slowdown from 2023, when the world population grew by 75 million people. In Jan 2025, 4.2 births and 2.0 deaths were expected worldwide every second, according to the estimates.

The US grew by 2.6 million people in 2024, and the US population on New Year's Day will be 341 million people, according to the Census Bureau. The US was expected to have one birth every 9 seconds and one death every 9.4 seconds in January 2025.

International migration was expected to add one person to the US population every 23.2 seconds. The combination of births, deaths and net international migration will increase the US population by one person every 21.2 seconds, the Census Bureau said. AP






