





U.S. President Donald Trump's increased tariffs on all steel and aluminium imports took effect on Wednesday, stepping up a campaign to reorder global trade norms in favour of the U.S. that drew swift retaliation from Europe.

Mr. Trump's action to bulk up protections for American steel and aluminium producers restores effective global tariffs of 25% on all imports of the metals, and extends the duties to hundreds of downstream products made from the metals, from nuts and bolts to soda cans and bulldozer blades.

Allies upset

Close U.S. allies Canada, Britain, and Australia criticised the blanket tariffs, with Canada mulling reciprocal actions, and British Business and Trade Secretary Jonathan Reynolds saying "all options were on the table" to respond in the national interest.

Australian Prime Minister Anthony Albanese said the movewas "entirely unjustified... and against the spirit of our two nations' enduring friendship" but ruled out tit-for-tat duties.

The run-up to the tariff deadline came with some drama on Tuesday as Mr. Trump threatened Canada with doubling the duty to 50% on its steel and aluminium exports to the U.S.

But the U.S. President backed off those plans after Ontario Premier Doug Ford agreed to suspend his province's decision to impose a 25% surcharge on electricity exports to the States of Minnesota, Michigan, and New York until earlier U.S. tariffs were removed.

EU strikes back with tariffs on U.S. imports

The European Union (EU) on Wednesday announced that it will impose countertariffs on U.S. imports, retaliating against President Donald Trump's steel and aluminium tariffs, hours after they came into effect.

The countermeasures will amount to tariffs on €26 billion of U.S. goods entering the EU, equivalent to Mr. Trumps targeting of \$28 billion of EU goods entering U.S. markets.

"We deeply regret this measure," European Commission President Ursula von der Leyen said, referring to Mr. Trump's move to impose 25% tariffs on steel, aluminium, and products based on these from the EU and other jurisdictions.

The U.S. tariffs will impact 5% of all EU goods exports to the U.S., the EU said in a statement.

The first Trump administration had initially applied these tariffs in 2018. They are referred to as "Section 232" tariffs, named after a provision under U.S. trade law permitting tariffs for reasons of "national security". The EU response would consist of allowing current suspensions of counter-measures to tariffs imposed during Mr. Trump's first term to expire at the end of the month, resulting in a return to higher tariffs from April I.

The EU would then consider targeting another approximately C18 billion of U.S. imports to reflect the fact that the current U.S. tariffs impact a broader range and higher value of EU exports to the U.S. This second stage would be fully in place by April 13.

"In the meantime, we remain fully open to negotiations," Ms. Von der Leyen said, emphasising that it was not in America's or the EU's interest to burden their economies with such tariffs.

The EU will also begin consulting individual member countries on the measures immediately. The proposed list of products being targeted includes industrial goods such as steel and aluminium products, leather, and textiles. It also includes agricultural goods such as poultry, beef, seafood, nuts, dairy, sugar, and vegetables.



Indian Railways to dig ponds under govt.'s Mission Amrit Sarovar

The Indian Railways will dig ponds as part of the Union government's Mission Amrit Sarovar that aims to address the critical issue of water scarcity in the country.

Amrit Sarovar was launched in April 2022 with the ambitious goal of constructing or rejuvenating 75 ponds in each district of the country. The project made significant progress and as of October 2024, more than 68,000 ponds have been completed, rejuvenating surface and groundwater availability in various regions. These ponds have not only addressed immediate water needs but also established sustainable water resources.

Phase 2 of the mission was launched with a renewed focus on ensuring water availability, with community participation (Jan Bhagidaari) at its core. It aims to strengthen climate resilience, foster ecological balance, and deliver lasting benefits for future generations.

As part of these initiatives, the government roped in the Railways for desilting, excavating identified waterbodies or constructing new ones at suita-

ble sites in the vicinity of railway lines.

Railway authorities were told to request the respective district authorities to identify possible sites for the creation of new waterbodies near railway worksites.

Former India all-rounder Syed Abid Ali passes away

Sports Bureau HYDERABAD

Former India all-rounder Syed Abid Ali passed away on Wednesday. He was 83.

A medium-pace bowling all-rounder, Abid played 29 Test matches for India, scoring 1018 runs and taking 47 wickets. One of the finest cricketers from Hyderabad, he made a fantastic start to his Test career against Australia in Brisbane in 1967-68, when he registered impressive figures of six for 55, his career-best. Later in the same series, he scored 78 and 81, showcasing his potential with the bat.

He was a member of the Indian team led by Ajit Wadekar that won the historic Test at The Oval in 1971, after bowling out England for only 101 in the second innings.

The four-wicket win, coupled with the other two Tests (Lord's and Old Trafford) ending in a draw, saw India register its first-ever series win in England.

A fine fielder, Abid notably opened both the batting and bowling for India in seven Tests: against New Zealand in February 1968 and September/October 1969 and against the West Indies in February and April of 1971.

India, Mauritius sign eight pacts as PMs decide to elevate ties

India to build new Mauritius Parliament building, train 500 civil servants

NEW DELHI, MARCH 12

PRIME MINISTER Narendra Modi and Mauritius Prime Minister Navin Chandra Ramgoolam decided Wednesday to elevate the status of the India-Mauritius partnership to an "Enhanced Strategic Partnership".

The Indian government announced new infrastructure projects — small in scale and meant for the local communities worth 500 million Mauritian rupees (about Rs 100 crore). It will also build the new Parliament building in Mauritius. The two countries agreed to settle their mutual trade in local currency.

After the bilateral meeting in Port Louis, Prime Minister Modi said, "Today, Prime Minister Navin Chandra Ramgoolam and I decided to give the India-Mauritius partnership the status of 'Enhanced Strategic Partnership'."

"In the second phase of community development projects, new projects worth 500 million Mauritian rupees will be started. Five hundred civil servants from Mauritius will be trained in India in the next five years." he said.

THE INDIAN School of Mines in Dhanbad, which is an IIT, has secured the highest ranking for an Indian institution in the QS World University Rankings by Subject 2025, standing at rank 20 globally in 'Engineering –Mineral and Mining' subject, up from rank 41 last year.

Global higher education analysts Quacquarelli Symonds (QS) released the rankings by subject for 2025 on Wednesday. A total of 79 Indian institutions featured in the rankings, 10 more than last year.

Nine Indian institutions featured in the top 50 across subjects. In addition to the Indian School of Mines Dhanbad, these included the IITs in Delhi, Bombay, Madras, and Kharagpur, the IIMs in Ahmedabad and Bangalore, and the Jawaharlal Nehru University (JNU). The only private Indian institution that featured in the top 50 across subjects was Saveetha Institute of Medical and Technical Sciences, which was ranked 26 in Dentistry.

While it remains among the top 50, IIT Madras has seen a drop in its ranking, from 16 last year to 31 this year in Petroleum Engineering.

IIT Delhi was ranked 26 in Engineering and Technology, making it the best performing Indian institution in the subject, followed by IIT Bombay at rank 28. Both IITs have performed better compared to their ranking of 45 last year.

IIM Ahmedabad was ranked 27 in Business and Management Studies, while IIM Bangalore secured rank 40 in the same subject. Both institutions have dropped in their rankings compared to last year — IIM Ahmedabad was ranked 22, while IIM Bangalore was 32 last year.

The JNU has also seen a drop in its ranking from 20 last year to 29 this year in Development Studies.

India's top performing institutions in terms of the number of subjects they featured in (ranging from 18 to 29 subjects) in the rankings are the IITs — Bombay, Kharagpur, Kanpur, Madras, Delhi, Guwahati and Roorkee and the University of Delhi, JNU, and the Indian Institute of Science (IISc). Of these 10, IISc recorded a fall in rank in more subjects than a rise — its performance improved in five subjects and fell in six compared to the 2024 ranks,

Of these 10 institutions, eight saw their best ranks fall this year compared to last year. Among these are the older IITs – Bombay saw a highest rank of 25 last year and 28 this year; Kharagpur secured highest rank of 28 last year and 45 this year; Madras saw highest rank of 16 last year and 31 this year; Kanpur recorded highest rank of 36 last year and 51-100 this year; Guwahati saw highest rank of 42 last year and 51-100 this year.

IfT Delhi saw an improvement in its best rank, from 35 last year to 26 this year.

The highest rank that the University of Delhi secured was 51-100 in the Anthropology and Development Studies categories. In Development Studies, DU saw its rank drop from 43 last year, while in Anthropology it retained the 51-100 rank.

In law, O P Jindal Global Law University was the highest ranked Indian institution, in the 78th position. It was ranked 72 last year. National Law School of India University stood in the 201-250 rank band this year, having seen a fall from the 151-200 rank band last year.

The rankings cover 1,700 universities and 55 academic disciplines across 100 locations. The five indicators based on which the rankings by subject were determined: academic reputation, employer reputation, research citations per paper, H-index (based on number of citations), and the institution's international research network.

WFI suspension revoked



- The Union government revoked the suspension of the Wrestling Federation of India (WFI), restoring its status as a National Sports Federation (NSF).
- The suspension, imposed in December 2023, was lifted after the WFI shifted its office location and complied with governance norms.

- The suspension was imposed in December 2023 due to:
 - Sexual harassment allegations against former WFI President Brij Bhushan Sharan Singh.
 - Irregularities in governance, including WFI operating from the former president's residence.
 - Lack of transparency and violation of National Sports Code provisions.
 - Failure to function independently, with undue influence from previous leadership.

What is WFI?

- The Wrestling Federation of India (WFI) is the national governing body for wrestling in India.
- It is responsible for organizing national tournaments, selecting teams for international competitions, and promoting the sport.
- It operates under the Ministry of Youth Affairs and Sports and is affiliated with United World Wrestling (UWW).
- Headquarters: Delhi

Structure and Functions of WFI

- 1.Administrative Functions: Regulates and governs wrestling tournaments and events in India.
 - 1. Implements rules and regulations set by UWW and the Indian government.
- 2.Athlete Development & Selection: Conducts national-level selection trials for international competitions.
 - 1. Oversees training programs and wrestling camps.

- 1.International Representation: Affiliated with United World Wrestling (UWW).
 - 1. Ensures India's participation in Olympics, Asian Games, and World Championships.
- 2.Governance and Compliance: Must adhere to the National Sports Code.
 - 1. Required to maintain transparency and accountability in management.
