












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

The organisation con-veyed its decision to the Health Department and the State government on Saturday, According to the council, the names of the accused will be removed from its registry and hence they would be unable to continue their nursing stu-

lies in the State.
The KNMC has asked The KNMC has asked the college authorities to submit a fresh report on the incident, along with details of a complaint re-garding an incident report-ed two years ago, which will be considered in the next council meeting.

India, U.S. up dealings in underwater domain awareness

India and the U.S. are scaling up cooperation in underwater domain awareness (UDA) with a new initiative, the Autonomous Systems Industry Alliance (ASIA), announced during Prime Minister Narendra Modi's recent visit to Washington.

The alliance, aimed at scaling up industry partnerships and production in the Indo-Pacific region, has identified a range of UDA technologies for coproduction in India, official sources said.

Maritime domain awareness and increasingly, underwater domain awareness have become key focus areas both at a bilateral level and among the Quad group of India, Australia, Japan, and the U.S., especially given the rapid expansion of the Chinese Navy and its increasing presence in the Indian Ocean region.

The U.S. has offered a

few co-production and codevelopment opportunities for UDA technologies, sources in the know said. "India is the very first country with which the U.S. defence industry has offered to work with on these sensitive technologies," a source said.

The technologies include the Sea Picket autonomous surveillance system with sonar acoustic array produced by Thayer-Mahan; Wave Glider unmanned surface vehicle systems; low-frequency active-towed sonar; multistatic active (MSA) sonobularge diameter oys; autonomous undersea vehicles produced by Anduril; and Triton autonomous underwater and surface vehicle produced by Ocean Aero.

The joint statement issued after the talks between Mr. Modi and U.S. President Donald Trump said the leaders pledged to accelerate defence technology cooperation across space, air defence, missile,

maritime and undersea technologies, with the U.S. announcing a review of its policy on releasing fifthgeneration fighters and undersea systems to India.

Discussions are on between the U.S. companies and potential Indian partners regarding the identified technologies, sources said.

For the Wave Glider unmanned surface vehicle systems, negotiations are on between Boeing's Liquid Robotics and Sagar Defence Engineering for the co-production of 60

platforms in India. Similarly, for the low-frequency active-towed sonar, discussions are on with L3 Harris for co-development with Bharat Electronics Ltd.

For the MSA sonobuoys, a high-end technology which can be used to track submarines in the deep seas and oceans, India and the U.S. had announced a "first-of-its-kind partnership on co-production" in January.

As part of this, Ultra Maritime's sonobuoys will be co-produced in India in partnership with the defence public sector undertaking Bharat Dynamics Ltd.

According to the joint statement, the leaders also pledged to elevate military cooperation across all domains — air, land, sea, space, and cyberspace — through enhanced training, exercises, and operations, incorporating the latest technologies.

In this regard, they committed to break new ground to support and sustain the overseas deployments of the U.S. and Indian militaries in the Indo-Pacific, including enhanced logistics and intelligence sharing, as well as arrangements to improve force mobility for joint humanitarian and disaster relief operations along with other exchanges and security cooperation engagements.

At the Quad level, the statement said that as India looks to host the group's

summit later this year, the leaders will activate new Quad initiatives on "shared airlift capacity" to support the civilian response to natural disasters, and "maritime patrols" to improve interoperability.

While these technologies improve UDA, various other military platforms that India has procured from the U.S. augment its anti-submarine warfare capabilities in the Indian Ocean region, as well the interoperability among Quad partners as they have commonality.

These platforms include 12 P-8Is which are already in service; 24 MH-60R multi-role helicopters being inducted; 15 MO-9B Sea Guardian high-altitude long-endurance Unmanned Aerial Vehicles that were contracted as part of a deal for 31 MO-9Bs last October, with deliveries to begin from January 2029; and six more P-8Is that the leaders signed off on during the discussions earlier this week.

Karnataka tops the overall Devolution Index (DI) ranking of the Panchayat Raj system among States in India, while Kerala and Tamil Nadu are in the second and third spot, respectively.

The report titled 'Status of Devolution to Panchayats in States - An Indi-Evidence-Based cative Ranking' (2024) released by the Centre on February 13 says that Karnataka tops the chart in the DI and in the kev sub-indices of 'finances' and 'accountability'. Overall, the State has commendable performance across nearly all identified metrics.

States/UTs were ranked according to the overall panchayat DI and six key dimensions of framework, functions, finances, functionaries, capacity enhancement, and accountability. The Union Ministry of Panchayati Raj and the Indian Institute of Public Administration, New Delhi, prepared the report.

The report notes that Karnataka ranks first with an overall index score of 72.23 followed by Kerala (70.59), Tamil Nadu (68.38), and Maharashtra (61.44). While BJP-ruled Uttar Pradesh ranks fifth (60.07), Gujarat

Smartphone exports soar to record ₹1.5 lakh crore

iPhones lead with 70% share

RISHI RAJ New Delhi, February 16

SMARTPHONE EXPORTS FROM India hit ₹1.55 lakh crore during the April-January period breaking yet another record. Coming on the back of the government's production-linked incentive (PLI) scheme, they topped ₹1.31 lakh crore during FY24. Moreover, January reported the highest-ever monthly exports of ₹25,000 crore, an increase of 140% over January 2024.

The exports in the 10 months to January are 56% higher than the ₹99,120 crore worth of smartphone exports achieved by the industry in the

corresponding period of FY24. Nearly 70% of this was contributed by some of Apple's iPhone vendors with Foxconn, which operates out of Tamil Nadu, contributing about half. Exports from Foxconn exhibited a growth of 43% over the corresponding period of FY24.


Nearly 22% came from iPhonevendorTata Electronics, which has been accelerating production at its Karnataka unit after taking over from Wistron, while 12% came from Tamil Nadu-based Pegatron, in which Tata Electronics has recently acquired a stake. About 20% of the total smartphone exports were contributed by Samsung. The remainder is attributed to domestic companies and merchant exports.

Minister for electronics and information technology Ashwini Vaishnaw has said he expects smartphone exports to reach \$20 billion during FY25.

- 26 coastal nations, including India, Sri Lanka, Maldives, Oman, Indonesia, Australia, South Africa, and Somalia.
- Landlocked countries like Nepal and Bhutan also depend on IOR trade routes.

- Importance of the Indian Ocean Region (IOR):
- Global Trade Hub: Facilitates 70% of global container traffic and 90% of India's energy imports, making it a key economic corridor.
- Maritime Security: Critical sea lanes like the Strait of Malacca, Hormuz, and Bab el Mandeb ensure uninterrupted global trade.
- Resource-Rich Waters: Contains vast fisheries, oil, gas, and mineral deposits, crucial for regional economies.
- Strategic Significance: Hosts naval bases of major powers (US, UK, China, France), influencing global security dynamics.

- India's Role in Managing the Indian Ocean Region:
- SAGAR Initiative (2015): Launched by PM Modi to promote Security and Growth for All in the Region, ensuring maritime stability.
- Naval Capabilities & Regional Security: Indian Navy conducts joint exercises (MILAN, Malabar, Varuna) to strengthen regional defense cooperation.
- Economic & Trade Leadership: India develops ports via Sagarmala and promotes the Blue Economy for sustainable ocean resource utilization.

- <u>Disaster Relief & Humanitarian Assistance</u>: Plays a leading role in HADR operations, assisting countries during natural disasters and emergencies.
- <u>Diplomatic & Strategic Alliances:</u> Strengthens regional partnerships through IORA, BIMSTEC, and QUAD for collective maritime governance.

- Challenges in the Indian Ocean Region:
- China's Expanding Influence: String of Pearls strategy and growing naval presence challenge regional stability and India's interests.
- <u>Piracy & Maritime Crimes:</u> Somali piracy, illegal fishing, and arms smuggling disrupt trade and security operations.
- <u>Climate Change & Rising Sea Levels:</u> Small Island nations face existential threats due to coastal erosion and submergence risks.

Missing Children in India

- The Supreme Court was informed that nearly 36,000 children remain untraced across India since 2020, despite police recovering the majority of 3 lakh missing children.
- Total Missing (2020-24): Nearly 3 lakh children went missing.
- <u>Untraced Children:</u> 36,000 children remain missing, highlighting gaps in law enforcement.

• State-wise Data:

- Madhya Pradesh: 58,665 missing, 45,585 recovered, 3,955 still missing.
- Bihar and Odisha are next highest in order.
- Non-reporting States: Delhi, Punjab, Nagaland, Jharkhand, Tamil Nadu, West Bengal, J&K, Andhra Pradesh failed to provide data.

Government & Legal Measures

- Khoya-Paya Portal: Centralized online tracking system for missing children.
- Anti-Human Trafficking Units (AHTUs):
 - ₹100 crore allocated for strengthening AHTUs in every district.
 - Untraced cases (4+ months) must be transferred to AHTUs.

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
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
