The Union Health Ministry has issued a warning to the States and institutions that continue to function without regular transplant coordinators. It has cautioned them that a request for support for transplant coordinators would not be considered beyond the financial year 2024-25, specifically from States and institutions that have surpassed the five-year period for receiving such support.

Under the current National Organ Transplant Programme scheme (2020-21 to 2025-26), there is a provision for supporting government medical colleges with two transplant coordinators and a trauma centre; and private medical colleges that are performing well with one transplant coordinator.

Organ donation in India is regulated under the Transplantation of Human Organs and Tissues Act (THOTA), which States that



The transplant coordinator plays a critical role in coordinating the entire process of deceased organ donation and transplantation. This includes coordinating for brain stem death identification and certification, grief counselling, encouraging family members to consider organ donation, consent for donation and logistics management.



• Regulation under THOTA / THOTA के तहत नियम:

- The Transplantation of Human Organs and Tissues Act (THOTA) mandates that hospitals must appoint a transplant coordinator to be eligible for registration to conduct organ transplants. The ministry has urged states and institutions to establish permanent positions for these coordinators by the next financial year.

India, U.S. conclude \$3.5-billion deal for procurement of 31 armed UAVs

India and the U.S. on Tuesday concluded a \$3.5-billion deal for the procurement of 31 MQ-9B armed high-altitude long endurance (HALE) remotely piloted aircraft systems (RPAS) manufactured by General Atomics through an inter-governmental agreement, via the Foreign Military Sales programme of the U.S.

One contract was signed with the U.S. government for Tri-Service procurement of 31 MQ-9B Sky/Sea Guardian HALE systems, the Defence Ministry said. "Another contract has been signed with General Atomics Global India Pvt Ltd for performance based-logistics for these RPAS through Depot Level Maintenance, Repair & Overhaul in India," the Ministry said on X. The contracts were inked in the presence of Defence Secre-

tary Giridhar Aramane.

The deal also includes 170 AGM-114R Hellfire missiles; 16 M36E9 Hellfire captive air training missiles; 310 GBU-39B/B laser Small Diameter Bombs (SDB); and 08 GBU-39B/B LSDB guided test vehicles with live fuses among others.

Force multiplier

The deal for 31 MQ-9B UAVs, 15 Sea Guardians for the Indian Navy and 16 Sky Guardians— eight each for the Indian Army and Air

Force— was formally approved by the Cabinet Committee on Security last week along with another major deal for the indigenous construction of two Nuclear Attack Submarines (SSN).

These advanced UAVs, once inducted, will significantly augment India's Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance (ISR) capabilities. For the Navy, it is a great force multiplier in keeping an eye over large swathes of the Indian Ocean Region and will re-

duce the wear and tear on its P-8I long-range maritime patrol aircraft.

As reported by *The Hindu* earlier, end-July the Defence Acquisition Council chaired by chaired Defence Minister Rajnath Singh had approved amendments to the MQ-9B deal related to indigenous content and related aspects.

40-hour capacity

The MQ-9B is designed to fly over the horizon via satellite for up to 40 hours, depending on the configuration, in all types of weather, and safely integrate into civil airspace, according to its manufacturer. For instance, the Sea Guardian configuration can include a 360-degree surface-search maritime radar, automatic identification system, sonobuoy monitoring system, and sonobuoy dispensers for persistent anti-surface and anti-submarine warfare missions.

Greenwashing refers to claims by companies about any product or service having climate-friendly im-pact. The guidelines, is-sued by the Consumer Affairs Ministry, aim at ensuring eco-friendly asser-tions are backed by verifiable evidence and clear

ble evidence and clear disclosures. Briefing the media, Con-sumer Affairs Secretary Nidhi Khare emphasised the guidelines did not pro-hibit environmental claims but sought to ensure they are made with integrity and transparency. "The claims have to be supported by verifiable evi-

supported by verifiable evi-dence and independent studies," she said. For instance, terms like '100% eco-friendly', 'zero emissions', and 'cruelty-

free' must now be substatiated with accurate and accessible qualifiers.

SpaceX, Jio spar yet again over satellite spectrum allocation

The issue of satellite spectrum allocation resurfaced over Monday and Tuesday, as reports emerged that Reliance Jio had written to the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI), urging that airwaves for satellite Internet services such as SpaceX's Starlink should be allocated through auctions.

International telecom and satellite firms have urged the Union government to not follow the auction route, pointing out that unlike cellular spectrum, satellite spectrum for Internet is typically shared among multiple operators, and is not scarce.

Reacting to reports on Jio's letter to TRAI, SpaceX founder Elon Musk said that auctions for satellite spectrum would be 'unprecedented'.

On Tuesday, Sunil Mittal, the chairman of Bharti Enterprises Ltd., said that satellite firms seeking to serve "elite retail customers" in urban areas would have to "buy" spectrum.

However, the company issued a statement hours after his remarks, clarifying that Airtel "did not support the auction of satellite spectrum."

In past regulatory filings, Reliance Jio and SpaceX representatives have differed on this issue. Jio has argued that there is no legal basis for administratively allocating spectrum, an argument that largely relies on the Supreme Court's 2012 judgment in



the 2G spectrum case.

Minister of Communications Jyotiraditya Scindia said in response to a query on Jio's auction demand that the Telecommunications Act, 2023 already ensured that satellite spectrum allotment could only be done through the administrative mode. "That does not mean that spectrum does not come without a cost," Mr. Scindia said. "That cost will be decided by TRAI. They have already circulated a paper, and they are empowered by the Constitution to decide the administrative pricing [for telecom authorisations]."

The Minister was speaking on the sidelines of the World Telecommunication Standardisation Assembly.


Mr. Scindia's remarks indicated that the government was not considering auctions any more. "India is not doing anything different from the rest of the world," Mr. Scindia said. "Conversely, if you do decide to auction it, then you'll be doing something that's different from the rest of the world. For those of us that understand a bit of engineering ... satellite spectrum, because it is a high level of spectrum, beyond 7-8GHz [it] is shared. If it is shared, then how can you price it individually?," he asked.



UAE to review India's concerns over silver import surge: Centre

India-UAE CEPA, that took effect in 2022, permits unlimited imports of gold, silver, platinum and diamonds from UAE into India

ndia has raised concerns over a jump in imports of silver products, platinum alloy and dry dates from the UAE and urged the country to ensure that the rules are not circumvented under the free trade agreement (FTA), according to an official statement on Tuesday.

The UAE has agreed to examine the concerns raised by India, the Commerce Ministry said.

Following a significant rise in imports, India sought review of certain provisions of the FTA with the UAE that came into force on May 1, 2022.

The Indian delegation was led by Additional Secretary in the Department of Commerce Ajay Bhadoo. Assistant Undersecretary for International Trade Affairs, Ministry of Economy of the UAE, Juma Al Kait co-chaired the meeting.

Rules of origin

"Indian side raised the issue related to the recent surge in imports of silver products, platinum alloy and dry dates and urged the UAE to verify compliance with the rule-oforigin norms and ensure the rules are not circumvented." the Ministry said.

The UAE is the third-largest trading partner of In-

dia with \$83.65 billion in bilateral trade in 2023-24.

Import surge

Seeking an urgent review of the pact, think tank Global Trade Research Initiative (GTRI) said the India-UAE CEPA allows unlimited imports of gold, silver, platinum and diamonds from the UAE into India. The GTRI claimed many imports did not meet rules of origin norms and hence, did not qualify for concessions.

India's gold and silver imports from UAE skyrocketed 210% to \$10.7 billion in 2023-24.

India allows 7% tariffs, or customs duty concessions, on import of unlimited quantities of silver and a 1% concession on 160 metric tonne of gold.

The Indian side also urged the Indian Jewellery

Exposition Centre in Dubai be categorised a Designated Zone so that the benefit of concessional duties can be availed by domestic jewellery manufacturers, including non-registered entities, under the UAE's domestic regulation.

"[The] UAE side conveyed its willingness to examine this request after consulting its internal stakeholders, including federal tax authorities." it said.

Further, the Indian side highlighted the need for professional bodies from both sides to enter into mutual recognition agreements to enable professionals such as chartered accountants, lawyers, nurses to provide services without the need for another certification.

Both sides agreed to work on an actionable plan in this regard.

TUESDAY CHINA ON announced plans to launch a manned lunar mission, construct a lunar space station and explore habitable planets and extra-terrestrial life to expand its space programme in the next few decades.

China's top space bodies unveiled a national mid- and long-term development programme for space science, which will guide the country's planning of space science missions and space research from 2024 to 2050.

Anestablished space power, China in recent years built its own space station which is currently in operabesides tion launching several space missions.

including a lunar probe that collected samples for the first time from the far side of the Moon and brought them back to Earth for scientific studies.

The programme released by the China Academy of Sciences (CAS), China National Space Administration and the China Manned Space Agency to the media here outlined the goals of China's space science, including 17 priority areas under five key scientific themes, and a threephase roadmap.

research station initiated by China will be constructed during the second phase from 2028 to 2035, Ding Chibiao, vice president of the CAS, told the media here. The programme also outlines a roadmap for the development of space science in China through 2050.

In the first phase, leading up to 2027, China will focus on the space station operation, implementing the manned lunar exploration project, the fourth phase of its lunar exploration programme and the planetary exploration project.

Under the new plan, scien-

tists will also explore the habitability of celestial bodies in the solar system and exoplanets and search for extraterrestrial life, he said.

Key areas of space develop-

ment in the coming years will be the origin and evolution of the solar system, characterisation of planetary atmospheres, the search for extraterrestrial life, and exoplanet detection, Ding said.

The theme of the extreme universe focuses on exploring the origin and evolution of the universe, revealing the physical laws under extreme cosmic conditions, dark matter and the universe's origin and evolution, as well as the detection of cosmic baryonic matter.

BEML to make India's first bullet train

STATE-RUN BEML has been awarded the contract for the design, manufacturing, and commissioning of two high-speed trainsets, each comprising eight cars by Integral Coach Factory (ICF), the company said in a filing to the stock exchanges on Tuesday.

"The price of each car is Rs 27.86 crore and the total contract value is Rs 866.87 crore which includes design cost,

one-time development cost, non-recurring charges, one time cost towards Jigs, fixtures, tooling and testing facilities, which will be utilised for all future High-Speed projects in India," the company added. BEML said that this project marks a significant milestone in India's high-speed rail journey and will see the first indigenously designed and manufactured trainsets with a test speed of 280 kmph.

The company operates in three verticals- Defence & Aero-

These trains will be part of India's 508-km-long high-speed rail corridor from Mumbai to Ahmedabad

space, Mining & Construction and Rail & Metro, and has stateof-the-art manufacturing facilities located in Bengaluru, Kolar Gold Fields, Mysore, Palakkad, with R & D infrastructure.

On September 5, 2024, ICF issued a tender to build two

high-speed trainset (also referred as a rake), designed to reach a top speed of 280 km/h and operate at 249 km/h.

These trains will be part of India's ambitious 508 km long high-speed rail corridor from Mumbai to Ahmedabad. Initially, the corridor was planned to have Japanese E5 series Shinkansen high-speed trains, but due to high prices quoted by the Japanese companies, the government decided to manufacture these trains domestically.





'Marriage penalty': Employment rate for Indian women drops by 1/3rd

New Delhi: While men command a premium to get a job after marriage, women face a "marriage penalty" resulting in a sharp drop in their labour force participation, a new World Bank report says.

It estimates that in India, post-marriage female employment rates drop by 12 percentage points, about one thirds of the female pre-marital employment rate, even in the absence of children. In contrast, there is a 13 percentage point premium for men post-marriage. While the premium for men erodes after five years, it persists for women.

among women without children persists up to five years after wedding in India and Maldives," the report says, while asserting that social norms may also be at the root of the "marriage penalty".

To make matters worse for women, there is also a "child penalty" as they are entrusted with childcare responsibilities, forcing many to opt out of the workforce.

India, and South Asia in general, have poor female labour force participation rate, estimated at 32% in 2023, and with most countries, barring Bhutan, in the bottom quartile of World Bank's sample. "Women with more than secondary schooling or those who marry men with more than secondary schooling are less likely to be hit by the marriage penalty, suggesting education has a role in mitigating it," it said.

- Impact of Marriage on Employment / विवाह का रोजगार पर प्रभाव:
