



Calling it a "black day" for Indian democracy, the Congress accused the ruling party of "strangulating" democracy by trying to silence the voices of Mr. Gandhi and other Opposition leaders. It would fight the battle legally as well as politically, the party said and announced a nationwide agitation against the disqualification.

Is the authority of the Speaker final in this regard?

The Supreme Court in its ruling in *Lok Prahari v Union of India* (2018) clarified that a disqualification triggered by a conviction will

be reversed if the conviction is stayed by a court. "Once the conviction has been stayed during the pendency of an appeal, the disqualification which operates as a consequence of the conviction cannot take or remain in effect," the ruling said.

The notification by the House Secretariat regarding Rahul will cease to be in effect if and when his conviction is stayed.

Why has the Lok Sabha Secretariat issued this notification?

It is part of the procedure. In a note on October 13, 2015, the Election Commission of India had asked state chief secretaries to issue appropriate instructions to the department dealing with prosecutions to ensure that cases of conviction of sitting MPs or MLAs were brought to the notice of the Speaker or Chairman of the House, and to the Chief Electoral Officer of the state, along with the order of conviction within seven days of the order.

Section 8(3) of the Representation of the People Act, 1951 states that "a person convicted of any offence and sentenced to imprisonment for not less than two years shall be disqualified from the date of such conviction and shall continue to be disqualified for a further period of six years since his release."

Thus, the disqualification is triggered by the conviction itself, and not by the Lok Sabha notification. The notification is merely a formal notice to Rahul, who was in Lok Sabha on Friday before the House was adjourned.

In the case of a disqualified MLA, the notice is issued by the Vidhan Sabha concerned. For example, in the case of Samajwadi Party MLA Azam Khan, the Uttar Pradesh Legislative Assembly Secretariat issued the notice of disqualification in October last year.

What does Rahul lose along with his membership of Lok Sabha?

As a Lok Sabha MP, Rahul was entitled to a house in Lutyens' Delhi. Following his disqualification, he will have one month to vacate his 12 Tughlak Lane home, according to sources in the Housing and Urban Affairs Ministry. Rahul had been allotted the house after being elected MP from Amethi in 2004.

The Lok Sabha Secretariat has sent a copy of the disqualification notification to the liaison officer of the Directorate of Estates for further action. The sources said since the bungalow belongs to the Lok Sabha pool of residential properties, the action for its vacation would have to be initiated by the Lok Sabha Secretariat.

Rahul also loses all other perks that a Member of Parliament enjoys.

When do the people of Wayanad get a representative back in Lok Sabha?

The Election Commission can announce a byelection to the seat — in Azam Khan's case, the schedule for the byelection to Khan's 37-Rampur seat (along with byelections to fill four other vacancies across the country) was announced within a few days.

However, in the more recent case of Lakshadweep MPPP Mohammed Faisal, the EC, which had announced the bypoll on January 18 after the MP's conviction, had to withdraw the announcement on January 30 after Faisal's conviction was suspended by the Kerala High Court on January 25.

What options are available to Rahul Gandhi here onward?

His disqualification can be reversed if a higher court grants a stay on the conviction or decides the appeal in his favour. His first appeal would have to be before the Surat Sessions Court, and then before the Gujarat High Court.

If he does not get relief from the courts, he will be disqualified from contesting elections for eight years — two years of his sentence, plus six years under the provisions of the RP Act.

His lawyer Kirit Panwala moved an application before the Surat court on Friday seeking time to file an appeal.

Indra Sawhney & Others v. Union of India (also known as the Mandal verdict) was an Indian landmark <u>public interest litigation</u> case.

The constitution recognized social and educational backwardness, but not economic backwardness.

The court upheld separate reservation for OBC in central government jobs, but excluded these to the "creamy layer" (the forward section of a backward class, above a certain income).

At no point should the reservation exceed 50%





rench President Emmanuel Macron faced mounting pressure on Friday after violent demonstrations that left more than 400 security forces injured and the centre of major cities shrouded in tear gas and smoke. Over 450 people were arrested on Thursday during the most violent day of protests since the start of the year against Mr. Macron's bid to raise the retirement age to 64.

"There were a lot of demonstrations and some of them turned violent, notably in Paris," Interior Minister Gerald Darmanin told the *CNews* channel while giving figures for the number of arrests and in-

jured. Over 900 fires were lit around the capital on Thursday, he said, with radical anarchist groups blamed for setting uncollected rubbish ablaze and smashing shop windows, leading to frequent clashes with riot police.

In Bordeaux, protesters set fire to the entrance to city hall, briefly raising fears for the whole building until firefighters arrived to extinguish it.

"Why would you make a target of our communal building, of all people of Bordeaux? I can only condemn it in the strongest possible terms," the mayor of Bordeaux, Pierre Hurmic, told *RTL* radio. Over a million people marched nationwide on Thursday, with the protest movement reinvigorated by Mr. Macron's tactics and statements over the last week.

Uproar over legislation to change the retirement age has created another huge domestic crisis for the president 10 months into his second term in office. But Mr. Darmanin, a hardliner in the government, dismissed calls from political opponents and protesters to withdraw the pensions reform.

Parineeta, he was known for his work in the ad film industry. After the success of Parineeta, Sarkar also directed movies such Laaga Chunari Mein Daag (2007) and Lafangey Parindey (2010). A Delhi College of Art graduate, he also worked as a film editor, writer and producer.

Prior to joining the film in-

dustry, he shot several popular music videos of songs such like Euphoria's *Dhoom Pichak Dhoom* and *Maaeri*. He was made the video of Shubha Mudgal's *Ab Ke Saawan*. In the recent years, he had worked on some web-series including Zee5's *Duranga* (2022).

Many film personalities, including Hansal Mehta, Ashwiny Iyer Tiwari, Ajay Devgn and Manoj Bajpayee, expressed their grief and shock on social media over his demise.

"The news of Pradeep Sarkar's demise, 'Dada' to some of us, is still hard to digest.RIP Dada," Devgn said.

Starbucks CEO Narasimhan to work as a 'barista'

STARBUCKS' NEW CEO Laxman Narasimhan has said he will work as a barista once a month in stores to stay close to the company's culture, customers, challenges and opportunities.

Narasimhan, 55, officially became the Seattle-based coffee giant's chief executive on Monday, taking the reins from Howard Schultz about two weeks earlier than scheduled.

He was welcomed as incoming chief executive officer of Starbucks with a coffee tasting in the place where it all began – at Seattle's Pike Place market store.

In a letter to the employees on Thursday, the Indian-American business executive said he will always bea "fierce advocate" for the company's partners and its culture.

"With you, I've experienced every aspect of the business to learn what it truly means to wear the green apron. You've welcomed me into our stores, trained me in how to be a barista...all to help me deeply understand what we do, how we do it, and the challenges



and opportunities facing us," he wrote. Barista is a person who serves in a coffee bar. "To keep us close to the culture and our customers, as well as to our challenges and opportunities, I intend to continue working in stores for a half day each month," he was quoted as saying by CNN.

"I thought it was very important for me to put myself in the shoes of the partners and really understand what they do and how they do it. There were things I learned through experience in all of this. It taught me alot," he said in a statement.



The sarus crane is listed in <u>Schedule IV of the Wildlife Protection Act of 1972</u> and as <u>vulnerable on the IUCN Red List</u>, and it is predominantly found in <u>India</u>, <u>Southeast Asia</u>, and <u>Australia</u>.

Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia

The Prime Minister paid tribute to Dr. Ram Manohar Lohia on his birthday (March 23, 1910 – October 12, 1967).

Ram Manohar Lohia was a prominent figure in socialist politics and in the movement towards Indian independence.

He was a committed supporter of Mahatma Gandhi's non-violent struggle against British rule and participated in the Quit India movement in 1942.

प्रधानमंत्री ने डॉ. राम मनोहर लोहिया को उनके जन्मदिन (23 मार्च, 1910 - 12 अक्टूबर, 1967) पर श्रद्धांजलि अर्पित की।

राम मनोहर लोहिया समाजवादी राजनीति और भारतीय स्वतंत्रता के आंदोलन में एक प्रमुख व्यक्ति थे। वह ब्रिटिश शासन के खिलाफ महात्मा गांधी के अहिंसक संघर्ष के प्रतिबद्ध समर्थक थे और उन्होंने 1942 में भारत छोड़ो आंदोलन में भाग लिया था। Lohia's early political career began with the **Congress Party**, where he held the position of secretary of the Foreign Department of the **All-India Congress Committee (A.I.C.C.)**, the Congress Party's highest body.

In 1963 Lohia became a member of the Lok Sabha after a by-election in Farrukhabad (Lok Sabha constituency). He also won the Lok Sabha general election of 1967 from Kannauj (Lok Sabha constituency) but died a few months later.

1963 में लोहिया फर्रुखाबाद (लोकसभा निर्वाचन क्षेत्र) में उपचुनाव के बाद लोकसभा के सदस्य बने। उन्होंने कन्नौज (लोकसभा निर्वाचन क्षेत्र) से 1967 का लोकसभा आम चुनाव भी जीता लेकिन कुछ महीने बाद उनकी मृत्यु हो गई।

- Lohia and other CSP members left the Congress in 1948.
- He **became a member of the Praja Socialist Party** upon its formation in **1952** and served as general secretary for a brief period, but **internal conflicts** led to his **resignation in 1955**.
- He **established a new Socialist Party** (1955), for which he became chairman as well as the **editor of its journal, Mankind**.
