

The exhaust from the planes that ferried ministerial delegates to Baku for the climate conference, which concluded on Sunday, has barely settled. Yet, some of them found themselves on the red-eye to this coastal city to lay the foundations of a new United Nations-mediated treaty to end plastic pollution – and potentially the production of plastic.

On December 1, representatives from 175 countries would hope that this fifth and anticipated final round of discussions of the Intergovernmental Negotiations Committee (INC), following those in Punte Del Este (Uruguay), Paris (France), Nairobi (Kenya) and Ottawa (Canada), will result in an agreement.

Periodic meetings

Were the Busan negotiations to prove successful, next year will see a convention where Ministers from signatory nations will likely adopt the text and set the ground for periodic meetings – akin to the annual climate Conference of Parties (CoP) – to evolve a legally binding treaty to progressively weed out plastic.

"The historic Paris Agreement of 2015, where the world finally agreed to limit emissions to keep temperatures from breaching 2 degrees Celsius, took 21 CoP meetings. We cannot wait for 21 years to end plastic," said Inger Andersen, Executive Director, UN Environmental Programme.

The United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change was adopted in 1992 and entered into force in 1994. More than 170 countries will converge in the Republic of Korea, to negotiate a new legally binding global treaty to end plastic pollution, including marine pollution.

About

- Background: In 2022, the UN Environmental Assembly convened in Nairobi, to debate the global plastic crisis.
 - 175 nations voted to adopt a global treaty for plastic pollution—agreeing on an accelerated timeline so that the treaty could be implemented as soon as 2025.

- The negotiations are whether to agree to binding limits on certain classes of chemicals and on plastic production, or to settle on a package of funding aimed at improving trash collection and recycling.
 - Saudi Arabia, Iran, Russia, Kazakhstan, Egypt, Kuwait, Malaysia, and India have expressed resistance to stricter mandates and have instead proposed measures such as innovative waste management and sustainable plastic use.
 - On the other hand, Rwanda, Peru and the European Union have proposed ambitious targets for curbing plastic pollution.

Need for the Treaty

- Plastic production has skyrocketed across the world in recent decades.
 - The annual global production of plastic doubled from 234 million tonnes (mt) in 2000 to 460 mt in 2019.
 - Nearly half of this was produced in Asia, followed by North America (19%) and Europe (15%).
 - Plastic production is expected to touch 700 mt by 2040, as per the Organisation for Economic Co-operation and Development (OECD).

- Slow Decomposition: Plastic takes anywhere from 20 to 500 years to decompose, and less than 10% has been recycled till now, according to a 2023 study by The Lancet.
- Environmental Impact: Much of the plastic waste leaks into the environment, especially into rivers and oceans, where it breaks down into smaller particles (microplastic or nanoplastic).
 - This has severely impacted the environment and health of living beings.

- Impact on Humans: Exposure to chemicals in plastic can cause endocrine disruption and a range of human diseases including cancer, diabetes, reproductive disorders, and neurodevelopmental impairment.
- Climate Impact: In 2020, it generated 3.6% of global greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions, with 90% of those quantifiable emissions coming from plastic production, which uses fossil fuels as raw material.

India's Position


India does not support any restrictions on the production of polymers.

- Any restrictions are beyond the mandate of the UNEA's resolution adopted at Nairobi in 2022.
- The resolution also includes a **principle of national circumstances and capability** to allow developing countries to follow their development trajectories.

What is Plastic and Microplastics?

- The word plastic is derived from the Greek word plastikos, meaning "capable of being shaped or moulded."
- Plastic refers to a wide range of synthetic or semisynthetic materials that use polymers as a main ingredient with their defining quality being their plasticity – the ability of a solid material to undergo permanent deformation in response to applied forces.

- Microplastics: Plastics break down into their smaller units called microplastics – officially defined as plastics less than five millimetres in diameter.
 - 1. These microplastics find their way across the planet, from the depths of the Pacific Ocean to the heights of the Himalayas.
 - 2. According to the most recent global estimates, an average human consumes at least 50,000 microplastic particles annually due to contamination of the food chain, potable water, and air.

itching the upcoming Gelephu Mindfulness City as the biggest "cooperative project" in Bhutan, its Prime Minister, Tshering Tobgay, said here on Monday that he was grateful for India's support for the 2,500-sq. km "Zero Carbon" city being developed.

Mr. Tobgay was speaking at the first "Global Conference of the International Cooperative Alliance", inaugurated by Prime Minister Narendra Modi.

In his comments, Mr. Modi referred to Mr. Tobgay as his "younger brother", while Mr. Tobgay, speaking in Hindi for parts of his speech, referred to Mr. Modi as his "elder brother" and "mentor", and thanked him for his "guidance and support in the development of this unique city".

Nearly 3,000 delegates, including 1,000 representatives from 100 countries, are attending the five-day event being held in Delhi, hosted by Union Home Minister and Minister of

"The current situation in the world can be a big opportunity for the cooperative movement," Mr. Modi told those gathered at Delhi's Bharat Mandapam complex.

"For this, we will have to innovate and strategise our policies. To make cooperatives climate resilient, they should be linked to circular economy. It is also necessary to discuss how we can promote start-ups in cooperatives," he said.

In his speech, Mr. Shah said that the government had opened the way to prosperity for lakhs of villages, crores of women and farmers through its motto of "Prosperity through cooperation". He said that in three years, through two lakh new Primary Agricultural Credit Societies (PACS), there would not be a "single village panchayat" in India without a

cooperative society. He said many steps had also been taken to make the PACS modern, tech-enabled and economically viable.



THE UNION Cabinet on Monday approved the 'One Nation One Subscription' (ONOS) scheme, under which all centrally-run and state-run higher education institutions (HEI) will have access to reputed journals published by international publishers on a single platform. The platform is set to become operational on January 1, 2025.

Access will be provided through a national subscription,

coordinated by the Information and Library Network (INFLIBNET), an autonomous inter-university centre under the UGC.

Currently, there are ten separate library consortia under different ministries that provide access to journals for higher education institutions within their administrative remit. In addition, individual institutions subscribe to journals separately.

The scheme involves an outlay of ₹6,000 crore for three years, until 2027, and will provide subscriptions to around 13,000 journals published by 30 international publishers. Apart from higher education institutions run by the Centre and states, research and development institutions under the Centre will also be included, covering around 6,300 institutions.

INFLIBNET will make central payments to the 30 publishers, while institutions can continue to use their own budgets to subscribe to those not in the scheme.

Among the publishers in the scheme are Elsevier ScienceDirect, Springer Nature, Oxford University Press, Cambridge University Press, etc.

Flagship Atal Innovation Mission to go on, Cabinet allocates ₹2,750 crore

THE CABINET has approved the continuation of its flagship initiative, the Atal Innovation Mission (AIM), and allocated a budget of ₹2,750 crore to it for the period up to March 31,2028.

According to an official statement, AIM 2.0 is a step towards "Viksit Bharat" that aims to expand, strengthen and deepen India's already vibrant innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem.

"The approval underscores the government's commitment to fostering a robust innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem in India. With India at rank 39 on the Global Innovation Index and home to world's third-largest start-up ecosystem, the next phase of Atal Innovation Mission (AIM 2.0) is expected to further enhance India's global competitiveness.

"The continuation of AIM will directly contribute to creating better jobs, innovative products and high-impact services across sectors. While building on the accomplishments of AIM 1.0, such as Atal Tinkering Labs and Atal Incubation Centres, AIM 2.0 marks a qualitative shift in the mission's approach," the statement said.

AIM 2.0 involves piloting new initiatives to fill gaps in the ecosystem and scaling successes through central and state governments, industry, academia and community. "AIM 2.0 is designed to strengthen India's innovation and entrepreneurship ecosystem in three ways by increasing input (ushering more innovators and entrepreneurs), by improving the success rate or 'throughput' (helping more startups succeed) and by improving the quality of 'output' (better jobs, products," it said.

Cabinet nod to ₹2,481-cr Natural Farming Mission

New Delhi: The Centre on Monday announced National Mission on Natural Farming (NMNF) as a standalone Centresponsored scheme under the Ministry of Agriculture & Farmers' Welfare to promote natural farming among one-crore farmers across the country with a budget outlay of ₹2,481 crore.

The decision, taken in the Cabinet meeting headed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi, aims to create an ecosystem for sustainable farming.

"There is a need to improve the quality of soil and maintain the health of the people with chemical-free food...The National Mission on Natural Farming is a path-breaking decision," Information and Broadcasting Minister Ashwini Vaishnav said in a media briefing after the meeting, calling the move "path-breaking".

The mission, with a budget outlay of ₹2,481 crore, will cover 1 crore farmers across the country, he added.

The minister said natural farming will be promoted on a mission mode after successful experiments in 2019-20 and 2022-23. Currently, around 10 lakh hectares are under natural farming throughout the country, he added.

Titles: He decorated himself with high-sounding titles of Jayangonda, Pandya-kulasani, Singalantaka, Colamartanda, and Telingakulakala.



Stone records: He started prefacing stone records (official prasasti) with a set description of the major events of his reign.



Sri Brahadeeswarar Temple (Big Temple) also called Rajarajesvaram was built during his reign, and is part of the **UNESCO World Heritage Site** known as the Great Living Chola Temples.

Vijayalaya Chola	850-871 CE	Founded the Chola dynasty; captured Tanjore and built the Vijayalaya Choleeswaram temple.
Aditya I	871-907 CE	Expanded the Chola kingdom by defeating Pallavas; focused on temple construction.
Parantaka I	907-955 CE	Strengthened administration; annexed Madurai; made significant donations to temples.
Rajaraja I	985-1014 CE	Expanded the empire to Sri Lanka and the Maldives; built the Brihadeeswarar Temple at Thanjavur.
Rajendra I	1014-1044 CE	Led the successful Gangaikonda Cholapuram expedition; established Gangaikonda Cholapuram as the capital.
Rajadhiraja I	1044- 1054 CE	Led military campaigns against the Chalukyas and Pandyas; improved temple administration.
Rajendra II	1054- 1063 CE	Defeated Western Chalukyas in the Battle of Koppam; contributed to temple architecture.
Virarajendra	1063-1070 CE	Suppressed rebellions; patronized art and literature; focused on administrative reforms.

- **History**: It was founded in **London**, **England** in **1895** during the 1st Cooperative Congress.
 - Delegates from countries like Argentina, India, the USA, and others convened to promote cooperative principles and encourage international trade.

- The ICA provides a platform for cooperatives to collaborate, exchange ideas, and foster global trade while safeguarding cooperative principles.
- Membership: It unites over 1 billion cooperative members through 3 million cooperatives in various sectors, including agriculture, banking, health, and housing.
- With 306 member organizations across 105 countries, ICA serves as the leading voice for cooperatives, advocating for their interests and facilitating global collaboration and knowledge exchange.



- Global Cooperative Conference 2024
- It is a historic event as India hosts the ICA General Assembly for the first time.
- The Conference will also mark the official launch of the UN International Year of Cooperatives – 2025.
- Theme: "Cooperatives Build Prosperity for All."

• NCC:

- It also seeks to stimulate interest in national defence and build a reserve for the Armed Forces in emergencies.

National Gopal Ratna Awards, 2024


