Unite to uphold spirit of Constitution: Murmu

At event marking 75 years of Constitution's adoption, President urges executive, legislature, and judiciary to work together for public welfare. Vice-President cautions against placing creed above country; implores institutions to stick to jurisdictional area; Lok Sabha speaker urges MPs to follow tradition of debates set by the Constituent Assembly

The Indian Constitution is a progressive document, and it is the responsibility of the executive, legislature and the judiciary to work together to better the lives of common people in accordance with the spirit of the Constitution, President Droupadi Murmu said on Tuesday at an event to commemorate 75 years of the adoption of the Constitution. Speaking at the event held at the historic Central Hall of Samvidhan Sadan (old Parliament building), Vice-President Jagdeep Dhankhar stressed on the need to stick to the spirit of the Constitution. He said the country's "independence will be put in jeopardy if the various political parties placed creed above country. It is essential to ensure the separation of powers between the three organs of the state — executive, legislature and judiciary — Mr. Dhankhar said democracy functions

best when the Constitutional institutions work in tandem, adhering to their jurisdictional area". Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla urged members to follow the tradition of constructive and dignified debates, set by the Constituent Assembly, in both Houses of Parliament. Prime Minister Narendra Modi, Deputy Chairman of the Rajya Sabha Harkishan Singh Rawat, Leader of the Opposition in the Rajya Sabha Mallikarjun Kharge, Leader of the Opposition in the Lok Sabha Rahul Gandhi, Leader of the Rajya Sabha J.K. Naidu and Parliamentary Affairs Minister Kiren Rijju were seated on the dais.

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Netanyahu declares support for ceasefire deal with Hezbollah

Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu said on Tuesday that he would recommend his Cabinet adopt a U.S.-brokered ceasefire agreement with Lebanon's Hezbollah, as Israeli warplanes struck across Lebanon, killing at least 20 people.

The Israeli military also issued a flurry of evacuation warnings — a sign it was aiming to inflict punishment on Hezbollah down to the final moments before any ceasefire takes hold.

In a televised statement, Mr. Netanyahu said he would present the ceasefire to Cabinet Ministers later on Tuesday, setting the stage for an end to nearly 14 months of fighting.

Mr. Netanyahu said the vote was expected later on Tuesday. It was not immediately clear when the ceasefire would go into effect, and the exact terms of the deal were not released. The deal does not affect Israeli's war against Hamas in Gaza, which shows no

signs of ending. Hezbollah, meanwhile, kept up its rocket fire, triggering at least three deaths across northern Israel.

Lebanese officials have said Hezbollah also supports the deal. If approved by all sides, the deal would be a major step toward ending the Israeli-Hezbollah war that has inflamed tensions across the region.

The deal calls for a two-month initial halt in fighting and would require Hezbollah to end its armed presence in a broad swath of southern Lebanon while Israeli troops would return to their side of the border. Thousands of Lebanese troops and UN peacekeepers would deploy to the south, and an international panel headed by the United States would help for all sides' compliance.

Army's response

force and some fired weapons shots into the air. Still, Mr. Khan's wife, Bushra Bibi, who is leading the protests, made slow progress toward the square in a heavily guarded convoy, surrounded by well-armed Interior Minister Mohsin Naqvi threatened that security forces would respond with live fire if protesters fired weapons at them. "We have now allowed police to take any decision according to the situation," Mr. Naqvi said later while visiting the square.

Shinde quits as CM; succession row puts off gov. formation

Differences over the Chief Minister's post has further delayed the formation of the new government in Maharashtra. As the current Assembly's term came to an end on Tuesday, Chief Minister Eknath Shinde, accompanied by his wife, Geetika, and Deputy Chief Minister Ajit Pawar, submitted his resignation to Governor C.P. Radhakrishnan at the Raj Bhavan.

The Governor accepted Mr. Shinde's resignation, and asked that he serve as caretaker Chief Minister until a new Cabinet was sworn in.

"The Chief Minister tendered the resignation of his post and that of his Cabinet to the Governor on this occasion," the Governor said. He asked the Chief Minister to continue to hold the charge of the post till alternative arrangements are made," the Raj Bhavan said.

The decision over the Chief Minister's position is likely to take more time, and will happen only after a collective consultation with the central leadership, sources indicated to The Hindu.

Meanwhile, the Opposition has claimed that the pattern of victory of some Maharashtra candidates has been "irregularly similar". Nationalist Congress Party (NCP) chief Sharad Pawar is likely to appoint his allies to look into the concerns raised by his party leaders. "Our party wants to question the validity of EVMs. With all the confusion, the data will be consolidated at a central level and it will be guided by some lawyers," NCP (P) M.L.A. Rohit Pawar told The Hindu.

Impasse on naming CM
The impasse over selecting Maharashtra's next Chief Minister continued for the third consecutive day on Tuesday, with uncertainty lingering over whether Mr. Shinde would retain his position or whether the Chief Minister's position is likely to take more time,

NGT issues notice to Centre on expansion of glacial lakes

The National Green Tribunal (NGT) has issued notice to the Centre and others regarding the rapid expansion of the Himalayan glacial lakes, raising concerns over the increasing risk of natural disasters. The NGT took suo motu cognisance of a news report showing about 10.8% increase of the glacial lakes in the last 13 years due to the rising temperatures. As per the report, the melting of glaciers paved way for larger glacial lakes, which hold more water and, in turn, increased the risk of natural disasters such as floods and landslides. It directed the respondents to file their replies a week before the next hearing on March 10. ...

Murder victim's phone leads police to alleged 'serial killer'

The Haryana Government Railway Police and the West Bengal Criminal Investigation Department have unearthed inter-state links to an alleged 'serial killer' by tracing the mobile phone of a disabled passenger who was recently found dead on Kathiar Express. The accused, 30-year-old Bahub, alias Bhobu Karanwar Jat, is a resident of Haryana's Rohtak district and was recently nabbed by the Vadod Police in Gujarat, in connection with the alleged rape and murder of a 10-year-old college student. According to CID sources, the accused confessed to committing multiple crimes across states including the murder of the Kathiar Express passenger. ...

SC suggests fresh guidelines to deal with unruly flyers

On a plea by an elderly woman who was urinated upon on a flight, court says senior citizens may be given strategic seating; plea says Air India, DGCA failed to treat her with care and responsibility

The Supreme Court on Tuesday asked the Director-General of Civil Aviation to consider putting in place more comprehensive guidelines to deal with unruly passengers and fix accountability on flight crews. The court even suggested that the DGCA examine if senior citizens travelling by air could be strategically seated so that they would not fall victim to misbehaviour or be disturbed by others. A Bench of Justices B.R. Gavai and K.V. Viswanath issued the order on a petition filed by a 72-year-old woman last year. The woman related her harrowing experience when a drunk passenger relieved himself on her on an Air India flight from New York to New Delhi on November 26, 2022. She has sought clear, zero-tolerance guidelines for civil aviation and airlines. Additional Solicitor-General Ashwini Bharti, appearing for the Union government and the DGCA, said authorities lackon on this particular inci-

dent and others. Standard operating procedure, circulars and guidelines were already in place, including instructions to airlines. However, the court asked Mr. Bharti to take into consideration several suggestions made in the petition and consider the possibility of a 'senior citizen' category. The court listed the case after eight weeks. The petitioner, represented by senior advocate Gopudh Sankaranarayanan, said Air India and the DGCA had failed to treat the elderly woman with 'care and responsibility' after the passenger allegedly urinated on her. The woman said the cabin crew 'facilitated' the handling of her mobile-phone number to the man who allowed him to reimburse the cost of shoes, dry-cleaning, etc." The petitioner said she was made to sit on the 'very same seat' that was wet and smelled of urine. Her hearing was postponed when the crew 'concocted her to enter into a settlement with the passenger who urinated on her'. The plea had also highlighted how media reports on the incident concerning the senior citizen were 'full of conjectures and surmises'. She contended that these reports had 'severely undermined her rights as a senior citizen under Article 14, and in fact, has also affected the rights of the accused as well'. The petitioner had asked the court to consider how media reports based on conjectures may affect such senior citizens in the absence of clear guidelines. It had said media reports based on statistics tabled in Parliament, which showed ...

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Milk, meat and egg production increased in 2023-24: Centre

Milk production in the country saw a 3.76% increase in 2023-24 over the 2022-23 estimates, shows the Basic Annual Husbandry Statistics, 2024, prepared by the Animal Husbandry Department. Released by Union Minister Rajiv Ranjan Singh here on Tuesday, the report says the country produced an estimated 239.3 million tonnes of milk during 2023-24. According to the Ministry, this is a compounded annual growth of 8.62% over the past 10 years. In 2024-25, the milk production was 146.3 million tonnes, and in 2023-23, 230.58 million tonnes. India is at the top in milk production and second in egg production globally. Accounting for 16.2% of the milk produced in the country, Uttar Pradesh ranks at the top among the states followed by Rajasthan (6.9%), Gujarat (6.6%), and Maharashtra (6.7%). West Bengal recorded 8.26%, the highest annual growth rate in milk production in 2023-24. The total egg production is estimated at 142.77 billion during 2023-24, a compounded annual growth of 6.8% over the past 10 years. In 2024-25, it was 76.48 billion. "Further, the production has increased annually by 3.8% during 2023-24 over 2022-23 (49.28 billion number), the Ministry said. Andhra Pradesh is the largest producer of eggs with a share of 17.85% of total egg production in the country followed by Tamil Nadu (5.64%). The total meat production is estimated at 16.28 million tonnes during 2023-24. It registered a compound annual growth of 4.65% over the past 10 years. In 2023-24, 48.96% of the meat produced was of poultry, 2.6% of cattle, 18.09% of buffalo, 11.1% of sheep, 15.3% of goat and 3.72% of pig. ...

Mr. Madani asked the regional parties such as the Janata Dal(J) and Telugu Desam Party to oppose the Bill in the Lok Sabha. "If they support the government's Waqf Amendment Bill to remain in power, it would be like stabbing Muslims in the back. This dual politics, where they take votes from us and then use the power gained from these votes against us, cannot continue," he said. Mr. Ilyas said the Board representatives had met the JPC and presented their objections to the Bill. He said it was the Board which had asked all right-wing parties to join in the petition to reject the Bill. He said five crore people had sent in their objections to the Bill through the QR code, he said. ...



Milk, meat and egg production increased in 2023-24: Centre

Milk production in the country saw a 3.78% increase in 2023-24 over the 2022-23 estimates, shows the Basic Animal Husbandry Statistics, 2024, prepared by the Animal Husbandry Department.

Released by Union Minister Rajiv Ranjan Singh here on Tuesday, the report says the country produced an estimated to 239.3 million tonnes of milk during 2023-24. According to the Ministry, this is a compounded annual growth of 5.62% over the past 10 years. In 2014-15, the milk production was 146.3 million tonnes, and in 2022-23, 230.58 million tonnes.

India is at the top in milk production and second in egg production globally.

Accounting for 16.21% of the milk produced in the country, Uttar Pradesh ranks at the top among the States followed by Rajasthan (14.51%), Madhya Pradesh (8.91%), Gujarat (7.65%), and Maharashtra (6.71%). West Bengal recorded 9.76%, the best annual growth rate in milk production in 2023-24.

The total egg production is estimated as 142.77




Wheat vs Rice

No more tax increases, says U.K. Chancellor Reeves

U.K. Chancellor Rachel Reeves sought to assure British industry on Monday, saying she would not increase taxes for the remainder of the current Parliament, following the increases for companies and individuals announced in the Labour government's first budget on October 30. Ms. Reeves also said public services would not receive any more funding than what was already allocated and would have to live within their means. "We've now drawn a line under the fiction held by the previous government to put our public finances back on a firm footing and we've now set the budget for public services for the duration of this Parliament," Ms. Reeves told business representatives at the Confederation of British Industry conference. The cost of living and the economy were among

the top reasons for the swing away from the Conservatives in the July 5th general election, which saw the end of a series of Tory governments that ran the country for 14 years. The Labour government had said there was a public finance "black hole" of £22 billion left by the Conservatives. [This figure was disputed.] "Public services now need to live within their means, because I'm really clear I'm not coming back with more borrowing or more taxes," Ms. Reeves said on Monday.

The October budget had announced a £70 billion increase in spending in 2026-27 and a £40 billion tax increase, including an aggregate £26 billion increase in employer contributions via "national insurance", which is set to increase by 1.2% from next year. Other tax increases included ending the allowance on foreign assets and income for non-domiciled "non-doms" U.K. residents, a capital gains tax increase and higher "windfall tax" on energy companies. Some businesses have criticised the government for increasing the cost of employment. "Historically, we've been super bullish on the United Kingdom... going forward, it's becoming harder to understand what the case for investment is," Rajman Amin, CEO of snack food company Plinko, which owns makers of well-known British biscuit brand McVitie, said on Monday.

Judge grants dismissal of Trump's 2020 election case

A judge on Monday granted a request by prosecutors to dismiss the election subversion case against Donald Trump because of a Justice Department policy of not prosecuting a sitting President. Judge Tanya Chutkan agreed to the request by Special Counsel Jack Smith to dismiss the case against the President-elect "without prejudice", meaning it potentially could be revived after Mr. Trump leaves the White House four years from now. Mr. Trump was accused of conspiring to overturn the results of the 2020 election and removing top secret documents after leaving the White House. Mr. Trump, in a post on Truth Social, said the case was "empty and lawless, and should never have been brought."

Record 188 Russian drones hit Ukraine in night attack; national power grid damaged

Russia launched 188 drones against most regions of Ukraine in a nighttime blitz, the Ukrainian Air Force said on Tuesday, describing it as a record number of drones employed in a single attack. Most of the drones were intercepted, according to the Air Force, but apart from buildings and critical infrastructure such as the national power grid were

damaged. No casualties were immediately reported in the 17 targeted regions. Russia has been hammering civilian areas of Ukraine with increasingly heavy drone, missile and glide bomb attacks since the middle of the year. At the same time, Russia's Army has largely held the battlefield initiative for the past year and has been pushing hard in the east to Donetsk region where it is making significant tac-

Russian regions near the border with Ukraine. Meanwhile, Ukraine's General Staff said that over the past 24 hours, roughly half of the clashes along the almost 1,900-km front line occurred near Pokrovsk and Korakove in the Donetsk region. IMD: Cyclone developing in Bay of Bengal, heading towards Tamil Nadu

THE INDIA Meteorological Department (IMD) Tuesday announced the likely intensification of the existing deep depression into a cyclone by Wednesday and hit Tamil Nadu coast over the coming two days.

Once intensified, the storm will be identified as Fengal, a name proposed by Saudi Arabia. This is the second cyclone in the post-monsoon season to affect the Indian coast. In late October, cyclone Dana had crossed Odisha as a 'severe' category.

As per the latest meteorological updates, the prevailing deep depression over the northwest Bay of Bengal was located at about 280 km southeast of Trincomalee, Sri Lanka, 570 km south-southeast of Nagapattinam, 680 km south-southeast of Puducherry and 770 km south-southeast of Chennai.

"It is very likely to continue to move north-northwestwards and intensify further into a cyclonic storm by Wednesday. Thereafter, it will continue to move in the north-northwestward direction towards Tamil

Nadu coast and skirt the Sri Lankan coast during subsequent 2 days," the IMD said Tuesday.

Even though La Nina, the unusual cooling of the sea surface along the equatorial Pacific Ocean, is yet to emerge, 2024 is expected to be a La Nina year. According to IMD officials, during La Nina years, the cyclones that develop in the North Indian Ocean region (Bay of Bengal and the Arabian Sea) tend to clock a track and head towards Andhra Pradesh and Tamil Nadu coasts.

Locally, there have been cloudy and overcast sky conditions prevailing over Tamil Nadu and adjoining south interior Karnataka since Tuesday. Cold and windy conditions in these

regions have kept the temperatures below normal. The Met agency has warned of heavy to very heavy rainfall (up to 200mm in 24 hours) and extremely heavy rainfall (more than 200mm in 24 hours) over Tamil Nadu, Puducherry till Saturday. A 'red' alert has been issued for Tamil Nadu on Wednesday and an 'orange' alert on Thursday. Heavy rainfall will also affect coastal Andhra Pradesh, Yanam, Rayalaseema, Kerala and Mahe during the remaining days of this week.

Fishermen have been warned against venturing into sea, particularly over off Tamil Nadu and Sri Lanka coasts, till November 29 in view of the brewing storm.



- The cyclone, named *Fengal* (proposed by Saudi Arabia), is expected to move north-northwestward, making landfall along Tamil Nadu and skirting Sri Lanka.



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Why Income Tax Department has introduced PAN 2.0

THE 10-DIGIT alphanumeric Permanent Account Number (PAN) issued by the Income Tax Department is set to have a slew of upgrades — enhancement of the QR code feature for new and old cards, a completely online application process, and a merger of all existing identification numbers to make PAN as the common identifier for businesses.

The Union Cabinet approved the PAN 2.0 Project on Monday to make PAN the “single source of truth and data consistency”. With PAN already linked to Aadhaar, it is expected to become a strong source of identification and information for authorities.

Existing PAN cards will continue to be valid under PAN 2.0, according to the FAQs is-

sued by the Finance Ministry on Tuesday. The existing PAN holders need not mandatorily apply for the new card but can upgrade their PAN free of cost. Their number would remain the same even after the upgrade.

What is the PAN 2.0 Project?

PAN enables the Income Tax Department to link transactions such as tax payments, Tax Deducted at Source (TDS)/Tax Collected at Source (TCS) credits and income returns with the department. Essentially, PAN acts as an identifier for the person with the tax department and remains the same once allotted.

Further, TAN stands for Tax Deduction and Collection Account Number, a 10-digit alphanumeric number issued by the Income Tax Department. TAN has to be obtained by people responsible for deducting or collect-

ing tax at source. It is compulsory to quote TAN in TDS/TCS return, any TDS/TCS payment challan and TDS/TCS certificates.

Under the PAN 2.0 Project, with a financial implication of Rs 1,435 crore, the existing PAN system will be upgraded and its IT backbone will be revamped, Union Information and Broadcasting Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw said during the Cabinet briefing on Monday.

“There were repeated demands from the industry to have a common business identifier. They used to say they don’t want different (identification) numbers, a single number would be beneficial. The project will make efforts to make PAN as the common business identifier. All PAN/TAN/TIN will be clubbed under this system,” he said.

Currently, PAN-related services are spread across three platforms: the e-filing portal, the UTITTSI portal, and the Protean e-Gov portal. These services will now be integrated into a single, unified portal. “This one-stop platform will handle comprehensively

issues/matters related to PAN and TAN... By doing so, the I-T Department endeavours to simplify processes, eliminate delays, and improve grievance redressal mechanisms,” ac-

ording to the FAQs.

What are the features of PAN 2.0?

The QR code feature, which began in 2017-18, helps validate the PAN. This feature will continue with some enhancements.

The project also aims to set up a “mandatory PAN data vault system” for all entities

using PAN data, including financial institutions, government agencies, and central and state government departments through an online validation service.

“The PAN related information is used by many entities such as banks, insurance companies... So, those (entities) who take details of PAN, they will have to keep PAN data safely, mandatorily through the data vault system,” Vaishnaw said.

An official statement said the project will enable a technology-driven transformation of taxpayer registration services to improve ease of access and service delivery.

What does it mean for individuals and businesses?

Of the 78 crore PAN cards issued, 98 per cent belong to individuals. A senior Finance Ministry official told *The Indian Express* that

“PAN holders having an old PAN Card without QR code have an option to apply for a new card with QR code. In PAN 2.0, the submission of applications is going to be online (paperless).” Also, PAN 2.0 will help weed out duplicate PANs and minimise instances of one person holding more than one PAN, the Ministry said.

For businesses, this would mean a seamless, common system for filing various tax challans and returns. “In the PAN 2.0 Project all PAN/TAN related services will be hosted on a single unified portal of ITD.

The said Portal would host all end-to-end services related to PAN and TAN like allotment, updation, correction, Online PAN Validation (OPV), know your AO, AADHAAR-PAN linking, verify your PAN, request for e-PAN, request for reprint of PAN card etc.,” the FAQs said.



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Recalling stories of women who helped draft the Indian Constitution

ON CONSTITUTION Day (November 26), President Droupadi Murmu recalled the role women members played in the Constituent Assembly, the body tasked with formulating the Constitution of independent India.

The 299-member Assembly had 15 women members, including prominent figures such as Sarojini Naidu, Sucheta Kripalani, and Vijaya Lakshmi Pandit. But it also had lesser-known women from diverse backgrounds who participated in debates on gender, caste and reservations.

Ammu Swaminathan (1894-1978)

In the book *The Fifteen: The Lives and Times of the Women in India's Constituent Assembly*, authors Angellica Aribam and Akash Satyawali wrote that Swaminathan hailed from Palakkad, Kerala. Following her marriage to the much older Subbarama Swaminathan in her teens, she became interested in politics.

She strongly opposed the restrictions im-

posed on widows, such as shaving the head and renouncing jewellery, after seeing her mother's experience. Swaminathan contested Central Legislative Assembly elections on a Congress ticket from Madras in 1945 and then became a member of the Constituent Assembly. She spoke about the Hindu Code Bill and its relevance for gender equality: "When she mentioned that the Bill affects the women of the country more than the men, the male-dominant House erupted into laughter," the book said. Post-independence, she was elected to Lok Sabha from Dindigul, Tamil Nadu.

Annie Mascarene (1902-1963)

Mascarene was born in Trivandrum (now Thiruvananthapuram) in a Latin Christian family, considered to be at the lowest rung of the caste system. Despite her social status, she went on to study and teach law.

Lower-caste Ezhavas, Christians and Muslims could not vote in the local legislature at the time. Mascarene actively campaigned for a government based on a universal adult franchise, despite being targeted by her political opponents.

She later joined the Congress. As part of the Constituent Assembly, she spoke about the need for a strong Centre in the early days of the republic, while emphasising the autonomy of local governments. Mascarene contested as an independent candidate in 1952, winning from Thiruvananthapuram.

Begum Qudisia Aizaz Rasul (1909-2001)

Qudisia's father was a politician with roots in the royal family of Malerkota in Punjab. Her privileged background led her

to formal education but not without objections, with an ulama issuing a fatwa against her convent schooling.

Qudisia and her husband decided to join politics in 1936. Though conservative groups criticised her candidature, she won from a non-reserved seat. Despite being part of the Muslim League, she was among the few members opposing separate electorates based on religion. Her views on the idea of Pakistan were more complex. She believed it would help uplift Muslims but possibly harm poor Muslims in India fol-

lowing a division.

Ultimately, she decided to stay in India. Post-independence, she became a UP Rajya Sabha member in 1952.

Dakshayani Velayudhan (1912-1978)

Velayudhan marked several firsts — she was the first Dalit woman to graduate in science in Cochin (now Kochi) and the first Dalit woman in the Cochin Legislative Council. Belonging to the Pulaya community, considered a "slave" caste, upper-caste professors in her college would refuse to show her practical experiments.

After working as a teacher, she married a social worker at Mahatma Gandhi's Sevagram Ashram in Wardha. In 1946, she was elected to the Constituent Assembly from Malabar, aged 34.

She disagreed with Ambedkar on the need for separate electorates, saying the provision went against nationalism: "He is the only leader of the Harijan community and his non-co-operation with the nationalist forces is a great tragedy..."

Unlike her peers, she could not continue a political career due to financial difficul-

ties but remained involved in the Dalit movement.

Renuka Ray (1904-1997)

Ray was born in Pabna, present-day Bangladesh. Her father was a bureaucrat, while her mother was one of the first women students at Calcutta's Presidency College.

A meeting with Gandhi in 1920 led her to quit college and join the freedom struggle, where she went door-to-door to raise awareness. Ray later studied at the London School of Economics.

After her return to India and marriage, she was engaged in activism for women's issues, such as the rights to divorce and inheritance. Ray also represented women's organisations in the Central Legislative Assembly in 1943 and then became a member of the Constituent Assembly.

She opposed women's reservation in legislatures, saying it would be "an impediment to our growth and an insult to our very intelligence and capacity". Ray became a Lok Sabha MP in 1957.

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- **Annie Mascarene (1902–1963)**

- Born in a Christian family in Trivandrum, she overcame caste barriers to study and enter politics.
- She advocated for a strong central government while emphasizing local governance autonomy and was elected to the Assembly from Thiruvananthapuram in 1952.






Major Atmospheric Cherenkov Experiment (MACE) Telescope

- The Major Atmospheric Cherenkov Experiment (MACE) telescope, inaugurated in **Hanle, Ladakh**.
- **About**
- It is built collaboratively by Bhabha Atomic Research Centre (BARC), Tata Institute of Fundamental Research (TIFR), and Indian Institute of Astrophysics (IIA).
- Located at around **4.3 km above sea level**, it is the **highest imaging Cherenkov telescope** in the world.

- **Significance of MACE**
- Enables the **study of gamma** rays exceeding 20 billion electron volts (eV).
- **Explores astrophysical phenomena** near black holes, gamma-ray pulsars, blazars, and gamma-ray bursts.



Genetically Modified (GM) Maize

- 
- Scientists have found that the **Genetically modified (GM) maize**, which is illegal in India, has been detected in commercially sold processed and unprocessed maize grains in the country.
 - **What are GM crops?**
 - Crops that have undergone **genetic engineering processes** to alter their DNA are referred to as genetically modified crops.
 - This alteration is done **to introduce desirable traits** such as resistance to pests or herbicides, improved nutritional content, or increased yield.

- **Indian Scenario in GM crops**

- **Bt Cotton:** In 2002, the GEAC had allowed the commercial release of Bt cotton.

- Bt cotton has two alien genes from the soil bacterium *Bacillus thuringiensis* (Bt) that allows the crop to develop a protein toxic to the common pest **pink bollworm**.
 - Till now, it is the only GM crop that is allowed in India.
- 

- Many varieties of GM crops are under different stages of development, like **Bt brinjal** and **DMH-11 mustard**.


