Exactly what these 'control measures' and 'costs' are has not been specified yet. They are among a plethora of crucial undefined terms; in fact, there is still no agreed definition for the word 'plastic' as far as the treaty is concerned.

These and many other

concepts are at the heart of the negotiations, involving around 170 countries.

Officially called the 5th Intergovernmental Negotiations Committee (INC), which is administered by the United Nations Environment Programme (UN-EP), the talks are scheduled to conclude on December 1.

More ambitiously, the treaty aims at having countries cut the production of plastic itself and as a consequence, plastic polymers, which are components of most products undergirding modern economies.

India has a significant petrochemicals refining industry and while it has banned several kinds of single-use plastic, it has been far from successful at reining in plastic waste.

# 'A just transition'

In verbal 'interventions', where countries publicly raise their concerns to the INC Chair, the tenor of India's submissions is that speed ought not to trump the spirit of consensus, inclusivity, and transparency. While many countries have addressed various proposals in the several contact groups, India has so far restricted itself to

formal proposals on finance mechanisms.

India has also proposed that a new dedicated multilateral fund be created with contributions to be "additional and distinct" from other financial transfers. This fund would be governed by a duly constituted subsidiary body that will also facilitate "...transfer of technology from developed countries to developing countries, for achieving a just transition towards sustainable production and consumption of plastics, in accordance with national circumstances under the financial mechanism," India's submission added.

# Worried countries

While national representatives at these talks are in principle committed to an agreement, many are worried that a treaty on plastic pollution will restrict the production and supply of plastic and polymers, disrupting their economies. On the other end of the spectrum are Pacific island nations such as Tuvalu, Palau, and Fiji, who are demanding ambitious action on restraining both plastic waste and production. They point out that the marine pollution from dumping plastic waste as well as their limited capacity to respond has resulted in existential threats to their countries.




% of Women Married Before 18 Years of Age, India, NFHS-3, 4 & 5

- In the last five years, it declined by 3.5% points to reach 23.3% in 2020-21, according to the latest National Family Health Survey-5 data.
- There is a growing trend for decline in the overall prevalence of child marriage, but 23.3% is still a disturbingly high percentage in a country with a population of 141.2 crore.

- Eight States have a higher prevalence of child marriage than the national average:
  - West Bengal, Bihar and Tripura top the list with more than 40% of women aged 20-24 years married below 18, according to NFHS data.
- Some States have shown a reduction in child marriages, like Madhya Pradesh (23.1% in 2020-21 from 32.4% in 2015-16), Rajasthan (25.4% from 35.4%) and Haryana.

# Bill passed to keep children off social media


Melbourne: Australia's House of Representatives on Wednesday passed a bill that would ban children younger than 16 years old from social media, leaving it to the Senate to finalise the world-first law. The major parties backed the bill that would make platforms including Facebook, TikTok, Snapchat, Reddit, X and Instagram liable for fines of up to 50 million Australian dollars for systemic failures to prevent young children from holding accounts. The legislation was passed with 102 votes in favour to 13 against.


A 10% HIKE in US tariffs on imports could lower India's GDP growth by about 30 basis points, Morgan Stanley estimates, reports Saikat Neogi. New Delhi will have higher vulnerability to tariff hikes in sectors like machinery and transport equipment, chemicals, textiles, food and agri inputs. The US's weighted average tariff rate for India on MFN basis is around 3%, while Indian tariffs on US goods escalated in recent years, to touch 9.5% in 2022. India, however, lifted retaliatory duties on US apples and certain other crops in September 2023.

# Samsung gets first woman CEO outside founding family in 86 years

And now, South Korea's biggest conglomerate has named a woman that's not member of its founding family as CEO of a group company for the first time in its 86 years.

# Indians lost ₹11.3K cr to cyber fraud in nine months of 2024

#### **INDIA LOSTAPPROXIMATELY**

₹11,333 crore to cyber fraud in the first nine months of 2024, according to data compiled by the Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (I4C), a division of the ministry of home affairs (MHA).

Stock trading scams accounted for the largest share, with losses of ₹4,636 crore from 228,094 complaints. Investment-based scams caused losses of ₹3,216 crore from 100,360 complaints, while ₹1,616 crore was lost to 'digital arrest' frauds across 63,481 complaints.

Data from the Citizen Financial Cyber Fraud Reporting and Management System (CFCFRMS), showed nearly 1.2 million cyber fraud complaints

Prime Minister Narendra Modi recently cautioned citizens about 'digital arrest' frauds during the 115th edition of his 'Mann Ki Baat' radio programme. Stressing that no government agency contacts individuals via phone or video calls for investigations, Modi urged the public to remain alert. "There is no system like digital arrest under the law," he said, emphasising the importance of awareness to combat such scams.

An analysis of cyber frauds this year revealed that stolen money is often withdrawn using cheques, central bank digital currency (CBDC), fintech crypto, ATMs, merchant payments, and e-wallets. Over the past year, the I4C has frozen around 450,000 mule bank accounts, typically used to launder the proceeds of cyber crime.

At a recent anti-terror conference, the I4C flagged challenges faced by investigators in cyber fraud cases, including the anonymity of digital wallets, foreign money exchanges, lack of KYC protocols, VPN access, and cryptocurrency frauds originating from abroad.

In collaboration with the telecom ministry, the I4C has also blocked 17,000 WhatsApp accounts linked to cybercriminals operating out of Southeast Asia, as part of efforts to disrupt offshore criminal networks and strengthen India's digital security.

- India ranks in the **global top 10** for all three major intellectual property rights—**patents**, **trademarks**, and **industrial designs**.
- India ranks sixth globally with 64,480 patent applications in 2023.

- India's trademark office holds the second-largest number of active registrations worldwide with over 3.2 million trademarks in force.
- India's industrial design applications grew by 36.4% in 2023.
- Increase in IP Activity:
- India's patent-to-GDP ratio grew from 144 to 381 in the past decade, indicating an expansion of IP activity in line with economic growth. Patent-to-GDP ratio is a measure of the economic impact of patent activity.



- Peatlands are unique wetland ecosystems characterized by waterlogged conditions that slow the decomposition of plant material, leading to the formation of peat soils.
- These ecosystems consist of both the <u>organic-rich soil</u> (<u>peat</u>) and the wetland vegetation thriving on the surface.



## • <u>Distribution of Peatlands:</u>

- Found in nearly all countries, peatlands cover at <u>least 3% of the</u>
   <u>Earth's</u> land surface.
- The <u>Congo Basin</u> hosts the largest known tropical peatland, discovered in 2017.
