# Modi likely to visit U.S. to deepen strategic relations, says Trump

U.S. President Trump, however, adds a new dimension to the relationship soon after holding a phone call with the Prime Minister, calling for putting 'America first' in trade relations with major economies by imposing tariffs on 'outside countries'

Prime Minister Narendra Modi is likely to visit Washington, DC in February, U.S. President Donald Trump has said.  
in an announcement that came hours after Mr. Trump and Mr. Modi spoke over the phone on Monday, the White House called for a "fair bilateral trading relationship", and indicated that India would host the leaders of the Quad trilateral grouping in the coming months.  
"The two leaders discussed expanding and deepening cooperation. They also discussed a range of regional issues, including security in the Indo-Pacific, the Middle East, and Europe. The President em-

phasised the importance of increasing its procurement of defence equipment and moving toward a fair bilateral trading relationship," the White House statement said.  
"The leaders discussed plans for Mr. Modi to visit the White House, under-

press note said.  
Mr. Modi on Monday said he had a telephone conversation with Mr. Trump and had agreed to work for "global peace" and "security". "Congratulated him (Mr. Trump) on his historic second term. We are committed to a mutually beneficial and trusted partnership," the Prime Minister said.  
However, President Trump added a new dimension to the relationship soon after holding the telephone call with Mr. Modi, with the call for putting "America first" in trade relations with major economies. "We are going to put tariffs on outside countries," Mr. Trump told a gathering of House Republicans in Florida.  
"Well... they mean us harm, but they basically

want to make their country good. China is a tremendous tariff-maker, and India, Brazil, and so many other countries. But we are not going to let that happen any longer... because we are going to put America first," Mr. Trump said.  
The Trump administration held the Quad Foreign Ministers' meeting in Washington DC that was attended by External Affairs Minister S. Jaishankar.  
The leadership summit of the Quad grouping is expected in Trucherry in the coming months which will be held in India this time. The Trump administration has zeroed in on immigration, H1B visas and tariffs that are of great relevance to India's interest in its relations with Washington DC.

# Had frank, in-depth talks on issues of concern, says China

China on Tuesday said it stressed the need for properly handling differences and promotion of India-China relations on a stable track in the just-concluded talks with India's Foreign Secretary, Vikram Miri.  
In its readout in Mandarin, the Chinese Foreign Ministry said the dialogue focused on promoting the implementation of the important consensus reached by the leaders of China and India in the Kazan meeting on the sidelines of BRICS summit last year and discussed measures to improve and develop China-India relations. In the talks, China emphasised that the two sides should proceed from the fundamental interests of China and India and adhere to the strategic height and long-term perspective of China-India relations, it said.  
Both sides should actively promote dialogue, exchanges and practical cooperation with a frank and constructive attitude, positively guide public opinion, increase trust and resolve misgivings, properly handle differences and promote the development of ties on a healthy and stable track, it said. The two sides held a frank and in-depth exchange of views on issues of mutual concern, it said.  
It highlighted the consensus reached between the two sides during the talks which included the resumption of direct flights, the Kalash Manasarovar Yatra for Indian pilgrims and a meeting of the India-China Expert Level Mechanism to discuss the

resumption of the provision of sharing hydrological data pertaining to trans-border rivers.  
Areas of consensus  
Highlighting the areas of consensus reached between the two sides, it said India has expressed its willingness to fully support China's work as the rotating presidency of the Shanghai Cooperation Organisation (SCO) this year and will actively participate in various activities hosted by Beijing under the framework of the organisation.  
Also, the two sides agreed to use bilateral and multilateral occasions to carry out active interactions at all levels, strengthen strategic communication, and enhance political mutual trust, it said.  
Both sides agreed to jointly commemorate this year the 75th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic relations between China and India and will actively participate in various activities hosted by Beijing under the framework of the organisation.

# China's DeepSeek jolts tech world with a lean, mean AI model

A new player in the artificial intelligence (AI) race, the Chinese start-up DeepSeek, has created a buzz in global tech circles with the launch of its cutting-edge AI models, claiming they nearly match the capabilities of top industry leaders in the U.S. — all while being far more affordable. The company's AI model, DeepSeek-R1, has ignited a fresh debate over the shifting dynamics of the global AI market.  
Monday night's trading session on Wall Street left DeepSeek with a positive development as investors scrambled to make sense of the damage. AI chip maker Nvidia's market value declined by a billion dollars in the biggest single-session loss for any company ever. The impact reverberated across global markets as tech and AI stocks plummeted. Though the sell-off steadied on Tuesday, the low-cost Chinese AI model continues to be popular globally.  
"Wake up call" Commenting on the development from China, U.S. President Donald Trump said: "The release of DeepSeek AI from a Chinese company must be a wake-up call for our industries as we need to be laser focused on competing to win."  
Mr. Trump said DeepSeek was a positive development for the U.S. tech industry as they "will be doing that too and won't be spending that much to get the same results".

Moreover, cybersecurity experts have noted that it is critical to engage with DeepSeek with a degree of caution as the start-up operates within a regulatory environment where government oversight of data is stringent.

DeepSeek was founded in 2023 in Hangzhou, Zhejiang by Liang Wenfeng, co-founder of the Chinese quantitative hedge fund High-Flyer. The fund, known for its involvement in AI research and development, has played a key role in DeepSeek's growth, though the exact extent of High-Flyer's financial backing remains unclear.



# What is DeepSeek, the Chinese AI company?

What is DeepSeek? The ‘Sputnik’ backdrop What makes DeepSeek different? A frenzy over an artificial intelligence chatbot made by Chinese tech start-up DeepSeek was upending stock markets Monday and fuelling debates over the economic and geopolitical competition between the U.S. and China in developing AI technology.

DeepSeek’s AI assistant became the No. 1 downloaded free app on Apple’s iPhone store Monday, propelled by curiosity about the ChatGPT competitor. Part of what’s worrying some U.S. tech industry observers is the idea that the Chinese start-up has caught up with the American companies at the forefront of generative AI at a

fraction of the cost.

That, if true, calls into question the huge amounts of money U.S. tech firms say they plan to spend on data centres and computer chips needed to power AI advancements. But hype and misconceptions about DeepSeek’s technological advancements also sowed

confusion.

### **‘Not miracles’**

“The models they built are fantastic, but they aren’t miracles either,” said Bernstein analyst Stacy Rasgon, who follows the semiconductor industry and was one of several stock analysts describing Wall

Street’s reaction as overblown. “They’re not using any innovations that are unknown or secret or anything like that,” Mr. Rasgon said. “These are things that everybody’s experimenting with.”

The start-up DeepSeek was founded in 2023 in Hangzhou, China and released its first AI large language model later that year. Its CEO Liang Wenfeng previously co-founded one of China’s top hedge funds, High-Flyer, which focuses on AI-driven quantitative trading. The fund, by 2022, had amassed a cluster of 10,000 of California-based Nvidia’s high-performance A100 graphics processor chips that are used to build and run AI systems, according to a post that summer on Chinese social me-

dia platform WeChat.

The U.S. soon after restricted sales of those chips to China.

DeepSeek has said its recent models were built with Nvidia’s lower-performing H800 chips, which are not banned in China, sending a message that the fanciest hardware might not be needed for cutting-edge AI research.

DeepSeek began attracting more attention in the AI industry last month when it released a new AI model that it boasted was on par with similar models from U.S. companies such as ChatGPT maker OpenAI, and was more cost-effective in its use of expensive Nvidia chips to train the system on troves of data. The chatbot became more widely accessible when it appeared on Apple

and Google app stores early this year.

But it was a follow-up research paper published last week – on the same day as President Donald Trump’s inauguration – that set in motion the panic that followed. That paper was about another DeepSeek AI model called R1 that showed advanced “reasoning” skills – such as the ability to rethink its approach to a math problem – and was significantly cheaper than a similar model sold by OpenAI called o1. “What their economics look like, I have no idea,” Mr. Rasgon said. “But I think the price points freaked people out.”

Behind the drama over DeepSeek’s technical capabilities is a debate within the U.S. over how best to compete with China on AI.



OpenAI, maker of ChatGPT, questions jurisdiction of Indian courts in copyright case

The GSLV-F15 mission will lift off in the early hours of Wednesday; the first launch, SLV-3 E10, had taken place in August 1979 when former President Abdul Kalam was the Director of the mission

The Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) will in the early hours of Wednesday oversee the historic 100th launch from the Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC) in Sriharikota with the GSLV-F15 mission.

The first launch, on August 10, 1979, was the experimental flight of Satellite Launch Vehicle-3 (SLV-3 E10) carrying the Rohini Technology Payload, which was only partially successful, according to the space agency. Former President A.P.J. Abdul Kalam, who was then with the ISRO, was the Director of the mission. Dr. Kalan and the ISRO officials recovered from the setback and tasted success with the SLV-3E2 a year later, on July 18, 1980, as the Rohini satellite, RS-1, was placed in orbit.

After this, the ISRO launched two more SLV missions; four Augmented Satellite Launch Vehicle (ASLV) missions; and five missions from its workhorse, the Polar Satellite Launch Vehicle (PSLV); the geosynchronous Satellite Launch

This recommendation is for adults (not pregnant women or children), and excludes individuals with kidney impairments or with other conditions that might compromise potassium excretion. The emphasis on salt — with so many recommendations on how much to consume and its constitution — is because of the

Cover GBS cases under State health scheme: Fadnavis

The Hindu Bureau MUMBAI

Amid the surge in Guillain-Barre Syndrome (GBS) cases, Maharashtra Chief Minister Devendra Fadnavis on Tuesday instructed officials to make necessary arrangements in a government hospital for the treatment of patients and cover the treatment under the Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Jan Arogya Yojana.

At a Cabinet meeting, Mr. Fadnavis took cognisance of the spread of the disease in Pune. "Treatment is under way, but government hospitals should make the needful arrangements to take care of GBS cases diagnosed with GBS. Currently, Mahatma Jyotiba Phule Jan Arogya Yojana covers the treatment of the disease, however, in case any further procedures are to be done, the Public Health Department must take care of it," Mr. Fadnavis said.

One person has died so far and 111 suspected cases have been reported till Tuesday. Of these, 31 have been confirmed as GBS cases. Twenty patients are from the Pune Municipal Corporation (PMC) area, 66 from the newly added

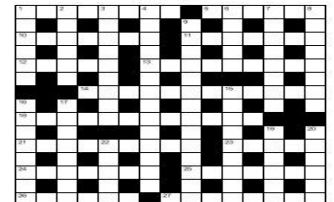

villages in the PMC area, 12 from Pimpri Chinchwad MC, five from Pune Rural, and eight are from other districts. Seventy-seven patients are men and 34 women. Thirteen patients are on ventilator support. The PMC has claimed that the possible reason behind the GBS cases was water contamination.

A total of 76 blood samples have been sent to the National Institute for Virology, Pune. All samples have tested negative for Zika, Dengue, and Chikungunya. Fifty-seven stool samples were tested for enteric virus panel; 17 were positive for Norovirus, and five for Campylobacter. Around 110 water samples from different parts of Pune try have been sent for chemical and biological analysis and samples from eight water sources were found to be contaminated.

The power of Abhirami Andhadhi (composed in Tamil) is reinforced by the unwavering devotion that 'Abhirami' Bhaktar had for Abhirami, the Consort of Amrithadevawara, the presiding deity at Tirukkadayar, said P. Swaminathan in a discourse. Like many evolved souls, Abhirami Bhaktar too was in the habit of conversing with the Higher Power. One day, (Anavasya in the Tamil month of Thai) the ruler Serfoji I arrived in Tirukkadayar, after completing the Anavasya rituals at the confluence of river Cauvery and the sea at Kaveripoampattinam. When the king and his entourage arrived, Bhaktar was fully absorbed in Abhirami and when the king asked him what day it was, he muttered, full moon day. noncommunicable diseases (NCDs) such as cardiovascular diseases (CVDs) and chronic kidney disease by lowering blood pressure. It also lowers the risks of other conditions associated with high sodium intake, such as gastric cancer, the guideline says.



It provides evidence-informed guidance on the use of lower-sodium salt substitutes, in which NaCl (sodium chloride) is partially replaced with KCl (potassium chloride) for household consumption of table salt, but not in packaged foods, or foods consumed outside of home. The recommendations are to be employed by policymakers, programme managers, health professionals among other stakeholders, to promote reduction of sodium intake.



Vivekanand Jha, executive director, The George Institute for Global Health

in India, says this guideline is very significant for India, given the propensity to add extra salt to everything. This is an appreciable effort to change behaviour, he says.

“Instead of targeting individuals with messages about reducing salt, it makes sense to change what is available to them at a population level, in this case, low sodium salt, and make it affordable to all,” Prof. Jha explains. He adds that the WHO guidelines clearly keep out persons who might have to be on a low potassium diet. Regular salt may still be available for them.



Dr. Priya, while endorsing efforts to reduce salt consumption, particularly given the culture in India, also flags the issue of putting people with possibly undetected kidney disease, on a potassium-enhanced salt alternative.

# 30 dead, 60 injured in stampede at Maha Kumbh

Pilgrims waiting for a dip at the Sangam trampled to death as a barricade collapses at Akhara Marg

U.P. govt. forms three-member judicial panel to probe incident; President, PM express grief

State govt. says 69 million took the holy dip till 6 p.m. on the auspicious day of Mauni Amavasya

**T**hirty people were killed and at least 60 injured in a stampede at the Maha Kumbh here on Wednesday. Authorities said pilgrims waiting for a dip at the Sangam at the auspicious hour were trampled after a barricade collapsed amid the surge of a massive crowd on Akhara Marg and people rushed to the other side.

“Unfortunately, 30 devotees lost their lives, while around 60 people suffered injuries. Between 1 a.m. and 2 a.m., before the *Brahma Muhurat*, a massive crowd built up on Akhara Marg in the Mela area,” Vaibhav Krishna, Deputy Inspector-General of Police, Maha Kumbh, said.

“The administration im-

mediately carried out rescue operations and cleared the crowd. Of the deceased, 25 have been identified, while the rest not yet.”

The stampede occurred on the day of Mauni Amavasya, considered auspicious for the dip at the confluence of the Ganga, the Yamuna and the mythical Saraswathi. Four of the deceased were from Karnataka, two from Gujarat and one from Assam.

“A few injured individuals have been taken by their families, while 36 are under treatment at a local medical college. The situation is under control,” the DIG said.

The Uttar Pradesh government announced a three-member judicial inquiry commission, headed by Justice Harsh Kumar (retd), a former judge of the Allahabad High Court.

The panel will look into what led to the incident.

The judicial panel will also look into preventive actions for the future.

The Uttar Pradesh government, in a statement,

said over 69 million people performed Snan (holy dip) till 6 p.m.

After the stampede, the administration issued an alert in Rae Bareilly, Chitrakoot, and neighboring dis-

tricts of Prayagraj with traffic moving towards the Maha Kumbh partially stopped. The district administration barricaded various places and intersections stopping

four-wheeler vehicles going to Prayagraj. Visitors are told that traffic will be restored after the crowd in Prayagraj subsides. The blockade led to thousands of vehicles trapped in massive jams.

President Droupadi Murmu and Prime Minister Narendra Modi expressed grief over the incident.

The President said, “The stampede incident at Prayagraj Maha Kumbh is extremely sad. I express my condolences to the families of the injured devotees and pray to God that all the injured devotees recover soon.”

Opposition leaders hit out at the BJP government alleging that mismanagement and focus on VIP movement led to the stampede.

Samajwadi Party (SP) president Akhilesh Yadav called for the Army to be

handed over the administration and management of the Maha Kumbh.

“In order to re-install faith in the system among the saint community and devotees who have come to the Maha Kumbh, it is necessary that the administration and management of the Maha Kumbh should be immediately handed over to the Army instead of the U.P. government and administration,” he said.

The SP president hit out at the Uttar Pradesh government, saying its claims of a “world-class system” had been exposed and those spreading propaganda should take moral responsibility for the people killed.

Centre asks airlines to curb airfare hike for Kumbh Mela

Following concern over "spiralling" airfares for flights to Prayagraj during the ongoing Maha Kumbh festival, the Centre on Wednesday advised airlines to ensure "reasonable" ticket prices for devotees. Iddigo said it had slashed airfares by 30% to 50% on all routes to and from Prayagraj. Civil Aviation Minister K. Ramamohan Naidu held a meeting with airline representatives "to review adequacy of air connectivity to Prayagraj from across the country while maintaining reasonable fares during the once in 144 years Maha Kumbh Mahotsav," the Ministry posted on X.

'Regularise absence of doctors who protested in R.G. Kar case'

The Supreme Court on Wednesday directed hospitals, including Delhi's All India Institute of Medical Sciences (AIIMS), to regularise the absence of doctors who protested against the rape and murder of a doctor at Kolkata's RG Kar Medical College and Hospital. The order was passed by a Bench headed by Chief Justice of India Sanjay Khanna in pursuance of an earlier order of the apex court on August 22, 2024, directing authorities not to take any coercive action against protesting doctors who return to duty. "We deem it appropriate to clarify that the period of absence during the case the protesting doctors have joined after the order dated August 22, 2024 will be regularised," the Bench cleared the air.

GBS feared in connection with 3 deaths in Bengal

Three persons in West Bengal have died after reportedly exhibiting symptoms of the Guillain-Barre Syndrome (GBS), potentially marking the States' first few casualties from the disease that has affected around 110 people in Maharashtra so far.

According to Health Department sources, 17 persons in West Bengal were currently receiving treatment for the disease. According to public health experts, GBS is an autoimmune neurological disorder in which one's own immune system attacks the peripheral nervous system. Weakness in the muscles and paralysis of the limbs are symptoms typically associated with this disorder.

Satish Lohar, a 48-year-old man from Dhabaichal in West Bengal's Hooghly district passed away on Wednesday, after being diagnosed with suspected GBS by a private medical practitioner the same morning.

Health Department sources have said that GBS is not a new or rare disease and that the situation in the State is being closely monitored.

Two deaths from Guillain-Barre Syndrome (GBS) and 16 fresh suspected cases were reported in Pune and other districts, the Public Health Department said on Wednesday.

The total number of cases mounted to 127 from the 111 till January 28.

A total of 23 patients are from the Pune Municipal Corporation area, 73 from newly integrated villages within its limits, 13 from the Pimpri-Chinchwad Municipal Corporation limits, five from Pune's rural areas and nine from other districts in Maharashtra.

Nearly 20 patients are on ventilator, show data of the Integrated Disease Surveillance Programme by the Public Health Department.

At least six suspected cases came to light in Sangli district on Wednesday and they have been admitted to various private hospitals in Sangli.

"Six patients have suspected GBS, but nothing to worry about as all these patients are from different areas. If all the cases are from one place, then only we can say it is an outbreak. However, we are checking the background for enteric virus passed, travelled," District Civil Surgeon, Sangli, Vikramsinh Kamal told The Hindu.

The six patients were hospitalised in the last six days, the doctor said. Three patients have been found in the Chintamani Nagar, Mardawadi, and Gudmashinghi areas of Sangli, two are from rural Sangli, and one is from

the Kolhapur border area. The Sangli Municipal Corporation's Health Department has been put on high alert.

The Health Department has sent 121 stool samples to the National Institute of Virology Pune, all tested for enteric virus passed. Twenty-one samples are positive for Norovirus, and are positive for Campylobacter.

Among 25 cerebrospinal fluid samples, one tested positive for Epstein-Barr virus.

All 200 blood samples have tested negative for Zika, Dengue, and Chikungunya.

HC grants bail to six accused in Govind Pansare murder case

The Bombay High Court on Wednesday granted bail to six accused in the 2015 murder of CPI leader, rationalist, and author Govind Pansare on the grounds of long incarceration.

A single Bench of Justice Anil S. Kilar allowed the bail plea of the six accused - Sachin Andure, Gansh Miskin, Amit Dewvekar, Amit Baddi, Bharat Kurane, and Vasudev Suryavanshi - considering they had spent over six years in prison. They were arrested on different dates in 2018 and 2019 and have been in prison since then.

Pronouncing the judgement, Justice Kilar observed, "The whole case of the prosecution is based on circumstantial evidence against the applicant and there is no prima facie case against the applicant. Moreover, there is no progress in the trial and if the period of incarceration of the applicant is considered, it is evident that the applicant is in jail for more than five years. Thus, considering the pace with which the trial is proceeding, and the number of witnesses remaining to be examined, it is evident that there is no end to the

trial in sight."

Justice Kilar in a detailed order said, "Considering the reasons and the long period of incarceration in the backdrop of the fact that there is no end of trial in sight, I am of the opinion that though the application was strongly opposed by learned APP assistant public prosecutor in prison since then, the applicant is entitled for grant of bail."

Bail application is allowed and disposed off, the order read. On January 2, 2025, a Division Bench of Judges, Justice Ajay S. Gadkari and Justice Kamal Khata observed that the court will no longer monitor the development in the investigation of the case as it was no longer necessary.

Pansare and his wife were shot at by two unknown assailants in Kolhapur on February 16, 2015. His wife survived.

Lack of a protective law exposes domestic workers to abuse, says SC

Anguished by the years of abuse an impoverished tribal woman from Chhattisgarh suffered as a domestic worker in the national capital and neighbouring cities, the Supreme Court on Wednesday directed the Union government to work on bringing a law to protect this burgeoning but unorganised workforce from exploitation.

"The simple reason for this harassment and rampant abuse, which seems to be prevalent throughout the country, is the legal vacuum which exists vis-à-vis the rights and protection of domestic workers. As a result, they frequently endure low wages, unsafe environments, and extended hours without effective recourse," the court observed in a judgment.

A Bench of Justices Su-

rya Kant and Ujjal Bhuyan ordered the Centre to form an inter-ministerial committee to "consider the desirability of recommending a legal framework for the benefit, protection and regulation of the rights of domestic workers". The committee must comprise experts from the Ministries of Labour, Women and Child Develop-

ment, Law and Justice and Empowerment. The report of the committee must be placed before the Union government in six months, after which the Centre would decide on the necessity of a law for domestic workers, for who were mainly women.

Justice Kant, who wrote the judgment, said the lack of a Central law was indeed a vacuum.

State laws The court drew attention to States such as Tamil Nadu, Maharashtra and Kerala which had not waited for a Central law but took the initiative to enact their laws to safeguard domestic workers. These three States had constituted specialised bodies under their respective laws to administer various social security benefits, maternity and childcare, education assis-

tance, and medical expense reimbursement, etc. The court noted that multiple attempts were made in the past to bring a Central law to protect domestic workers, from the Domestic Workers (Conditions of Employment) Bill of 1959 to the Domestic Workers (Regulation of Work and Social Security) Bill of 2017. None of these proposed laws were enacted.

Justice Kant said the demand for domestic workers was mounting in India in consonance with rapid urbanisation. However, this indispensable workforce remained the most vulnerable to abuse. Noting that, "Domestic workers often belong to marginalised communities, such as Scheduled Castes, scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Classes, and economically weaker Sections,"

Rooftop solar installation scheme reaches 8.5% of 1-crore house target

Nearly a year after the Centre launched the ₹25,000-crore PM Surya Ghar scheme, 8.5 lakh households have installed rooftop solar connections, Union Minister for New and Renewable Energy Pralhad Joshi said at a public event on Wednesday. First announced following the inauguration of the Ram temple in Ayodhya by Prime Minister Narendra Modi last January, the scheme was officially launched on February 15, 2024.

The scheme, on the whole, targets one crore household installations across India. Mr. Joshi said that this target is likely to be met within the next two or three years.

Last month, the Parliamentary Standing Committee on Energy remarked about the "slow pace" of


- **About The Apple Man of India:**

- **Who is Shri Hariman Sharma?**

- Shri Hariman Sharma is a visionary farmer from Paniala, Bilaspur (Himachal Pradesh), who overcame significant personal challenges to revolutionize Indian apple cultivation.
  - Despite being orphaned early in life, he pursued his passion for farming and pomology, introducing a self-pollinating apple variety that thrives in warm climates.

- **The HRMN-99 Variety**

- **Development:** The HRMN-99 apple variety was created in 1998 when Shri Sharma planted discarded apple seeds in his backyard, producing fruit even in warm conditions.
  - **Features:** HRMN-99 is a **low-chilling, self-pollinating** apple variety suitable for tropical and sub-tropical regions with temperatures of 40-45°C. It bears striped red-over-yellow apples with soft, juicy pulp, yielding up to 75 kg of fruit per plant annually.
  - **Adoption:** It has been successfully cultivated in 29 states and UTs, including non-traditional apple-growing regions like Bihar, Maharashtra, and Karnataka.
