Global Plastics Treaty draft overlooks key issue of limiting production, says group of countries






GDP Growth Performance

- India's real GDP growth fell to 5.4% in Q2 (July-September 2024), the lowest in seven quarters, compared to 6.7% in Q1.
- Gross Value Added (GVA) growth also declined to 5.8% from 6.8% in the previous quarter.

Global Plastics Treaty draft overlooks key issue of limiting production, says group of countries

Following five days of deliberation, countries have thrashed out a preliminary draft of the Global Plastics Treaty at the United Nations-led Global Plastic Treaty negotiations in Busan, South Korea.

However, a group of about 67 countries, including the European Union (EU) and a coalition of Pacific Island countries called the High Ambition Coalition, has said that the treaty does not go far enough to address the core purpose, which is to limit production and trade, and address the harm posed by many of the constituent chemicals used in manufacturing plastic.

The major points of dis-

agreement are proposals by the EU to have a global target to reduce the production of primary plastic polymers, steps to implement strategies and programmes to identify the risks of and protect against adverse health impacts associated with plastic pollution.

Playing safe

The Hindu has learnt that a group of countries, which includes India, Saudi Arabia, and China, is in favour of avoiding any language in reference to these subjects. This is largely because the manufacture of polymers, a raw material for plastic, is a major industry.

Sources said that chemicals that are known to be hazardous are only includ-

"We absolutely have to have 'production' (of plastic polymers) in the text. If not, it will double by midcentury and the weight of plastic in the ocean will surpass the weight of fish. If we cannot agree, then we are committed to voting on this issue," said Juan Monterrey, Head of Delegation for Panama, at a press conference on Friday.

Global Plastics Treaty Negotiations

A preliminary draft of the Global Plastics Treaty was discussed after five days of deliberations in Busan, South Korea.

The treaty focuses on reducing plastic pollution but has been criticized for overlooking the critical issue of limiting plastic production.

Criticism by High Ambition Coalition

A group of 67 countries, including the EU and Pacific Island nations, claimed the treaty fails to adequately address production and trade limitations.

These countries emphasize the adverse health impacts of plastics and the need for stricter chemical regulations.

India and Other Countries' Position

Scientific Evidence on Plastic Harm

- Studies show plastics harm human health and ecosystems, with only 6% of harmful chemicals currently regulated.
- Plastic in oceans could surpass the weight of fish by mid-century if production isn't curtailed.

Treaty Provisions and Gaps

- Critics demand stronger commitments to limit polymer production to prevent doubling by mid-century.







- Moiré materials are materials having unique properties due to the interference pattern formed when two repetitive structures are overlaid at a slight angle

Creation of Moiré Materials:
Moiré materials are created by stacking two layers of a two-dimensional (2-D) material, such as tungsten diselenide, and twisting one layer at a small angle (3.65°).

The twist between the layers creates a unique moire pattern that gives rise to new electronic behaviors not present in individual layers.

- Superconductivity is the property of certain materials to conduct direct current (DC) electricity without energy loss when they are cooled below a critical temperature (Tc).
- These materials also **expel magnetic fields** as they transition to the superconducting state.
- Superconductivity was discovered in 1911 by Heike Kamerlingh-Onnes. For this discovery, he won the 1913 Nobel Prize in Physics.
- E..g., MRI machines use an alloy of niobium and titanium.





Arrest of Chinmoy Krishna Das:

- On November 25, 2024, Chinmoy Krishna Das, a Hindu monk and former ISKCON member, was arrested at Dhaka's Shahjalal International Airport on charges including sedition.
- His arrest led to protests in Dhaka and Chittagong. During these protests, a
 Muslim lawyer named Saiful Islam Alif was killed in Chittagong, escalating tensions



Calls for ISKCON Ban: Following these incidents, Islamist groups such as Hefazat-e-Islam Bangladesh have demanded an immediate ban on ISKCON, labeling it an "anti-Hindu militant group."



Additionally, a writ petition was filed in the Bangladesh High Court seeking a ban on ISKCON, prompting the court to request a report from the state regarding the organization's activities

• Government Response:

- The Bangladeshi government has stated that it is scrutinizing ISKCON's activities.
- Attorney General Md Asaduzzaman referred to ISKCON as a "religious fundamentalist organization" and indicated that the government is monitoring the situation.
