

## Logjam ends, Parliament to debate Constitution

At meeting called by Speaker, the ruling party agrees to allow certain topics to be raised, but does not accede to any discussion on Adani indictment; Congress decides not to cause any disruption over the Adani issue, but announces protest outside Parliament complex for today; it says the agreement on debate is a 'climbdown' by the government

NEW DELHI

n a breakthrough to end the logjam that had plagued the functioning of Parliament for over a week, the government and the Opposition reached a consensus on holding a discussion on the Constitution in both Houses.

The Lok Sabha will hold the discussion on December 13 and 14 and the Rajya Sabha on December 16 and 17.

The ruling side agreed to allow certain issues such as the Bangladesh situation and the violence in Sambhal to be raised during Zero Hour, but did not accede to any discussion on the Adani indictment.

The main Opposition party, the Congress, decided not to disrupt Parliament over the Adani issue, but it will hold a protest outside the Makar Dwar of the Parliament complex at 10.30 a.m. on Tuesday.

Before the protest, at a meeting of INDIA bloc leaders, the Congress would ask other parties also to join the demonstration, sources said.

The breakthrough came at a meeting of floor leaders of all parties called by Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla, where the government conceded to the demand for holding a discussion on the Constitution. Congress

president Mallikarjun Kharge and Leader of the Opposition Rahul Gandhi had made the demand in separate letters to Rajya Sabha Chairperson Jagdeep Dhankhar and Mr. Birla, respectively, last week.

"The Lok Sabha Speaker met with floor leaders of all the parties. Everybody expressed their frustration on Parliament not functhe view that it was not appropriate to waste people's money. The Opposition also put forward their demand, there was a proposal in Business Advisory Committee to have discussion on the Constitution, the government has agreed to it," Union Parliamentary Affairs Minister Kiren Rijiju told presspersons.

However, the government refused to accede to a discussion on Adani indictment, arguing the developments had taken place in a foreign country, the sources said.

Congress sources, however, maintained that the decision to agree to a debate on the Constitution was a "climbdown" by the government.

At the meeting with Mr. Birla, the sources said, it was agreed that Samajwadi Party would be allowed to raise the Sambhal issue, Trinamool Congress the situation in Bangladesh and DMK the devastation caused by Cyclone Fengal in the Lok Sabha during Zero Hour on Tuesday.

#### Functioning to resume


Mr. Rijiju also mentioned the first Bill of the Session would be passed on Tuesday. The functioning of both Houses had been paralysed since the beginning of the Winter Session on November 25. The Lok Sabha and Rajya Sabha had functioned for just 67 and 93 minutes, respectively.

The development on Monday comes amid increasing isolation of the Congress over the stalling of Parliament over the Adani issue. Some Opposition parties felt that by stalling Parliament, the Opposition was falling into the trap of the government and would not be able to raise issues that concern people.

The Trinamool had notably been uncomfortable in allowing Parliament to be disrupted like this and had not been attending IN-DIA bloc meetings recently.



# Deals for 26 Rafale-M jets, 3 Scorpene submarines to be signed: Navy chief

NEW DELHI

Navy chief Admiral Dinesh Tripathi on Monday acknowledged that the country's second nuclear ballistic missile submarine, INS Arighaat, successfully fired a Submarine Launched Ballistic Missile (SLBM) a few days back. In another important remark on the country's strategic nuclear programme, he said the first of the two nuclear attack submarines (SSN) to be indigenously designed and manufactured is expected to be ready by 2036-37.

Two multi-billion dollar deals under negotiation with France to procure 26 Rafale-M fighter jets and three additional Scorpeneclass conventional submarines are in advanced stages and could be signed next month, the Navy chief

said in response to a question at the annual press conference ahead of Navy Day.

"It is just matter of completing the formalities of the acquisition process and we expect that if not this month, next month hopefully, this [Scorpène submarines] and Rafale-M deals should be signed."


fale-M jets, he said it was "one level short of taking it to the CCS [Cabinet Committee on Security]" for clearance, which will be followed by contract-signing. "It is a government-togovernment deal and hence I expect it to happen fast," he said.

The deal for three Scorpene submarines is a repeat order to Mazagon Dock Shipbuilders Ltd. (MDL), which is building them in partnership with Naval Group of France. Of the six submarines from the earlier contract, five have been inducted and the last one is expected to be commissioned later this month.

On the nuclear ballistic missile submarines (SSBN), Admiral Tripathi said the first one, *INS Arihant*, had done a number of deterrence patrols.

The second, INS Arighaat, which was commissioned recently, is undergoing trials, including missile test, he said.

"We did carry out test of missile... Launch was successful. Concerned agencies are examining as to what trajectory the missile took," he said on the recent K4 SLBM test with a range of 3,500 km from INS Arighaat.



# Oxford study lauds PRAGATI system for fast-tracking projects

NEW DELHI

A study by Oxford University's Saïd Business School has lauded Prime Minister Narendra Modi's PRAGATI infrastructure monitoring system for accelerating 340 projects worth \$205 billion across the country and bringing about economic transformation.

# 'Brain rot' named Oxford Word of the Year 2024

London: Many of us have felt it, and now it's official: "brain rot" is the Oxford dictionaries' word of the year. Oxford University Press said on Monday the evocative phrase "gained new prominence in 2024", with its frequency of use increasing 230 per cent from the year before.

It defines brain rot as "the supposed deterioration of a person's mental or intellectual state, especially viewed as the result of overconsumption of material (particularly online content) considered to be trivial or unchallenging".

The word of the year is intended to be "a word or expression that reflects a defining theme from the past 12 months". "Brain rot" was chosen by a combination of public vote and language analysis by Oxford lexicographers. AP

INDIA EXPERIENCED the second warmest November in 123 years, the India Meteorological Department (IMD) said Monday. A warming trend has continued over India since the post-monsoon season in October and could contribute to making 2024 the warmest year ever on record, globally.

At the recently concluded COP-29 in Baku, the World Meteorological Organization (WMO) said that the January-September 2024 global mean surface air temperature was 1.54 degree Celsius (°C) above the pre-industrial average. The global body also warned that the 2015-2024 decade was on its

way to be the warmest ever.

According to the IMD, the average maximum temperature recorded over the country in November was 29.37 °C — 0.62 degrees above normal. The average minimum temperature, too, was high last, with a deviation of 1.05 degrees above the normal mark of 15.86°C,

India's warmest November was in 2016, when the average maximum temperature was 29.75°C.

Meteorologists attributed the above-normal temperatures over India to two factors: the lack of strong western disturbances affecting the plains of northwest India and the lack of cyclonic disturbances (low pressure systems or likewise) — in the absence of which the rainfall activity remained at its lowest.

J&K Lieutenant Governor Manoj Sinha congratulated all stakeholders of the tourism sector of J&K on the launch of Uber Shikara. Commending Uber for their futuristic vision, he said the Uber Shikara in Srinagar is "a testament to creative ways technol-

ogy can enhance our cultural heritage."

Prabhjeet Singh, president, Uber India and South Asia said, "We are always looking to make mobility magical and effortless. Uber Shikara is our humble attempt to blend technology and tradition to give a seamless experience to travellers."

As part of the initiative, Uber has stated that the entire cost of the ride will be compensated to

the Shikara drivers, without Uber taking a cut, creating additional economic opportunities for the grassroots tourism workers in J&K. Each Uber Shikara ride can be booked for a period of 1 hour, up to four passengers. Uber Shikara rides can be booked 12 hours prior and up to 15 days in advance, the company said.

The shikaras will be available at predetermined government rates at the Dal Lake.

# Madhya Pradesh gets its eighth tiger reserve in Ratapani

BHOPAL, DECEMBER 2

THE RATAPANI Wildlife Sanctuary in Madhya Pradesh was on Monday declared a tiger reserve following in-principle approval from the Ministry of Environment, Forest, and Climate Change through the National Tiger Conservation Authority.

Officials said this will bring significant benefits. "Local communities will see economic opportunities grow with the promotion of ecotourism, which is expected to generate employment and improve livelihoods," said an official.

Officials said the tiger reserve designation enables the state to receive funding from the NTCA, which will "ensure better management and conservation efforts for wildlife".

"Eco-development programs are also set to provide further support to the region's inhabitants," said an official.

The notification delineates the core and buffer areas, making this the eighth tiger reserve in the state. The core area spans 763.8 square kilometers, while the buffer area covers 507.6 square kilometers, making the total area of the Ratapani Tiger Reserve 1,271.4 square kilometers.

Sitting in the lap of the Vindhya hills, the sanctuary en-

compasses a World Heritage Site – the Bhimbetka Rock Shelters – and many historical and religious destinations. It is located in the Raisen district with a substantial cover of teak forests and is less than 50 kilometres away from Bhopal.

The notification was issued under Section 38V of the Wildlife (Protection) Act, 1972, acknowledging the core area as a critical tiger habitat. This will cover nine revenue villages covering 26.947 square kilometers. "These villages have been integrated into the buffer zone. This decision ensures that the rights of local villagers within the sanctuary's boundaries will remain unaffected," said a wildlife officer.

# Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti and Sufism



- A Hindu Sena petition was admitted in an Ajmer court, claiming a Shiva temple lies beneath the Ajmer Sharif dargah, and calling for an archaeological survey.
- The dargah is the mausoleum of Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti, a key figure in the spread of Sufism in the subcontinent.
- The shrine was built by Mughal Emperor Humayun in his honor.

- Khwaja Moinuddin Chishti
- Early Life: He was born in 1141 CE in Persia (modern-day Iran) and was orphaned at 14. He embarked on a spiritual journey after meeting Ibrahim Qandozi, a mystic.
  - Moin-ud-din, believed to be a descendant of Muhammad.

**Spiritual Training**: Moinuddin studied various subjects in Bukhara and Samarkand before being initiated into the Chishti **Sufi** order by Khwaja Usman Harooni near Herat.

**Arrival in Ajmer**: in 1192 CE, Moinuddin arrived in Ajmer, during the decline of the Chauhan dynasty following its defeat by Muhammad of Ghor.

He chose to stay and help the suffering population.

**Title "Garib Nawaz":** Moinuddin earned the title **"Garib Nawaz"** (friend of the poor) for his selfless service, including building a refuge and langarkhana (community kitchen) for the homeless and needy.

**Contributions and Teachings:** Moinuddin interacted with **Hindu mystics and sages, sharing common values of devotion** and rejecting religious orthodoxy, focusing on equality and divine love.

Mughal Patronage: Emperor Akbar revered Moinuddin, made pilgrimages to his shrine, and helped beautify Ajmer, contributing to the city's revival.

**Legacy:** Moinuddin's teachings of love, compassion, and inclusivity continue to resonate in India's religiously diverse landscape, bridging cultural gaps between communities.

# India re-elected to U.N. Peacebuilding Commission

- India has secured its re-election to the United Nations
   Peacebuilding Commission (PBC) for the 2025-2026 term, reaffirming its commitment to global peace initiatives.
- About UN Peacebuilding Commission
- Established in 2005, the UNPBC is an intergovernmental advisory body that supports peace efforts in conflict-affected countries.
- It brings together key stakeholders, including UN agencies, regional organizations, and civil society, to develop comprehensive strategies for post-conflict recovery and peacebuilding.

- India's Contributions to UN Peacekeeping
- India is one of the largest contributors of troops to UN peacekeeping missions, with thousands of Indian peacekeepers deployed in various conflict zones.
- India is a significant financial contributor to the UN peacekeeping budget.
- India actively engages in diplomatic efforts to promote peace and stability, particularly in its regional neighborhood.

# E-Daakhil Portal

- The E-Daakhil portal, launched nationwide by the Department of Consumer Affairs, is now operational in all states and union territories, with its latest launch in Ladakh in November 2024.
- About: The E-Daakhil portal was launched on 7th September 2020 by the National Consumer Dispute Redressal Commission under the Consumer Protection Act 2019, amid the COVID-19 pandemic.

#### Features:

- It provides an inexpensive, speedy, and hassle-free mechanism for filing consumer complaints online.
- It lets consumers file complaints, pay fees, and track cases from home. Registration is simple via **OTP** on mobile phones or email addresses.

## **Usage and Impact:**

 Over 281,024 users have registered on the portal, with 198,725 cases filed and 38,453 resolved, addressing issues like faulty product compensation and financial grievances.

**Integration with E-Daakhil:** The government is also developing **e-Jagriti**, a platform to enhance case filing and resolution, aiming to transform consumer justice in India.
