



he Supreme Court on Monday asked Solicitor-General Tushar Mehta, appearing for the Centre, to suggest "regulatory measures" to rein in the use of "filthy language" and "vulgarity" which passes off as humour in programmes telecast online.

A Bench headed by Justice Surya Kant said there was a clear divide between humour and perversity.

The court said the regulatory measures were intended to ensure that programmes adhered to "well-known moral standards" of Indian society without sliding into a censorship of the fundamental right to free speech and expression. They were to work as a reasonable restriction on freedom of

speech to ensure decency and morality. The court said it wanted a "healthy debate" on the issue with inputs from stakeholders.

The Bench was hearing an application filed by You-Tuber Ranveer Allahbadia seeking a modification of a clause in a February 18 order of the top court, which had provided him interim protection from arrest in criminal cases registered in Maharashtra and Assam over his comments about parents and sex in the show "India Got Latent".

The clause in question barred him from airing or telecasting shows, podcasts, and so on.

Appearing for Mr. Allahbadia, advocate Abhinav Chandrachud said that his client had "no sense of humour", but the prohibition would affect his livelihood and that of his 280 employees who worked with Humour is an art. The court modified the bar, allowing Mr. Allahbadia to resume his podcast "The Ranveer Show", subject to maintaining "morality and decency" and making it suitable for viewers of all ages.

"Subject to the petitioner furnishing an undertaking to the effect that his whole podcast shows will maintain desired standards of decency and morality so that viewers of any age group can watch, the petitioner is permitted to resume 'The Ranveer Show'," the Bench said.

Mr. Mehta said humour for him was straightforward. "If you cannot make me laugh, you are not a good comedian," he said.

"Humour is an art. Humour is something that the entire family can enjoy and nobody feels embarrassed. That is talent. Using filthy language is not talent. Talent is using ordinary words to produce humour. We have excellent comedians in Bollywood. Writers of humour," Justice

Kant remarked.

Mr. Mehta said there were comedians who were "very critical" of the government, but did not cross the boundaries of decency and morality. "They are very good people," the top law officer noted.

In the hearing, Mr. Mehta said he was "curious" and had watched the show himself. "Humour is one thing. Vulgarity is another and perversity is at another level. This [the show] cannot be watched by the Attorney-General [who was present in the courtroom] or me together or Your Lordships... The very fact that he chose to take part in it... let him stay quiet for some time," the Solicitor-General, who also represented the States of Maharashtra and Assam, opined.

Justice Kant said the Bench hoped Mr. Allahba-

dia was experiencing "some repentance".

"People writing articles for him in the name of freedom of speech, we know how to handle them also... In this country, there is no fundamental right on a platter. Fundamental rights are enjoined by a duty," Justice Kant observed orally.

The judge said moral standards changed from one country to the other. The court was focused on the version followed by the Indian society.

Mr. Mehta said a regulatory mechanism was rightly owed to posterity.

Justice Kant clarified that people could watch whatever channel they wanted, but using filthy expressions to augment one's commercial brand was the problem. "That you can get away saying anything..." the judge said.

The application further requested the court to allow Mr. Allahabadi to travel abroad.

But Mr. Mehta said Mr. Allahbadia had not come when he was summoned by the Gauhati Police. Mr. Chandrachud responded that the Gauhati Police did not respond when Mr. Allahbadia had enquired through WhatsApp the date and time for his appearance at the police station.

The Bench directed the Gauhati Police to convey to the YouTuber the date and time of his appearance.

Justice Kant said the request to travel overseas would be considered after he joined the investigation. Meanwhile, the court extended the interim protection from arrest for Mr. Allahbadia.

The court will take up the case again on April 1.





Maintaining that develop-ing the dairy sector is prob-ably the only way to con-trol the exodus of people from villages to cities, Un-ion Home and Cooperation Minister Amit Shah said circularity in the sectos should not be limited to processing dung, but should include using skin and bones of the cattle and making machinery used in the segment in the cooperative sector.

Inaugurating a work-shop on "Sustainability and circularity in dairy sector" organised by the De-partment of Animal Hus-bandry and Dairying here on Monday, Mr. Shah di-rected the National Dairy Development Board Development Board (NDDB) to seek the possi-

Study finds 6,327 Gangetic dolphins across four States

Prime Minister Narendra Modi releases the report; since different methods were used for the previous counts, latest number will not be useful in gauging the change in population



 he first estimate of Gangetic dolphins. the only riverine dolphins in India, has found 6.327 of them in the Ganga and its tributaries. Previous attempts at mapping the population have relied on vastly different methods, and so the latest number is not useful for insight on whether their numbers have changed over time, experts associated with the study told *The* Hindu.

A press report by the **Environment Ministry on** Monday, World Wildlife Day, said there were 6,324 Ganges river dolphins, and three Indus river dolphins (a related species). There were an average 3,275 dolphins in the main stem of the Ganga; 2,414 in the Ganga tributaries; 584 in the Brahmaputra main stem; 412 in the Brahmaputra tributaries; and 101 in the Beas river. The effort began in 2021 and spanned a cumulative distance of 8,507 km.

Unlike the counting of tigers, elephants and other land animals in the forest,



counting dolphins is challenging. For one, the animals are under water and surface only sporadically to breathe. Second, unlike the tiger's stripes and the elephants' ears that can be caught on camera and used to distinguish one animal from the other, individual dolphins cannot be uniquely identified this way. For their survey, the researchers travelled by boat at a constant speed using acoustic hydrophones - essentially underwater microphones that pick up sounds emitted by the dolphins. The animals are blind and rely on echolocation to communicate and move.

"Using hydrophones and two different sets of observers on the boat, we triangulate the presence of a dolphin, and we also have to ensure that the same dolphin isn't counted twice," Qamar Qureshi, formerly of the Wildlife Institute of India and closely connected with the survey, said.



The dolphin report was officially made public on Monday by Prime Minister Narendra Modi on a visit to Gujarat, where he chaired a meeting of the National Board for Wildlife. He said that the local populations (in the Gangetic States) were important for conservation measures, and added that schoolchildren ought to be encouraged to visit dolphin habitat.

The highest number of dolphins were reported in Uttar Pradesh, followed by Bihar, West Bengal, and Assam.



GANGETIC DOLPHIN (Platanista gangetica gangetica)

It is a subspecies of South Asian River Dolphin.

Dolphins are **one of the oldest creatures in the world** along with some species of turtles, crocodiles and sharks. The Ganges river dolphin was **officially discovered in 1801**. But the species **is extinct from most of its early distribution ranges**.


• How is the FHI constructed?

THE COMPOSITE FISCAL health index (FHI) sources data on budgetary transactions for 18 states for FY2022-23 from the Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG). It's an aggregate of five major sub-indices, namely quality of expenditure, revenue mobilisation, fiscal prudence, debt index and debt sustainability. Each major sub-index has a few minor sub-indices. The nine minor sub-indices fall in two categories i.e., improvement index and deprivation index. The minor subindices under quality of expenditure, revenue mobilisation and debt sustainability are the improvement indices and those under fiscal prudence and debt index are the deprivation indices. The higher values of the variable under improvement index and lower values of the variable under deprivation index are rewarded. For example, Odisha is rewarded in the debt index with a score of 99.0 since its total debt has been declining since 2019-20, and its outstanding liabilities to GSDP ratio has been within the 25% target set by the FRBM. The arithmetic mean of the five major sub-indices yields the final composite FHI.




Sources of MUFA and PUFA:


