

India voted in favour of a United Nations General Assembly resolution that called for the withdrawal of Israel from the Palestinian territory occupied since 1967, including East Jerusalem. The resolution reiterated the call for achieving a comprehensive, just, and lasting peace in West Asia.


The draft resolution, "Peaceful settlement of the question of Palestine", tabled by Senegal, was overwhelmingly adopted in the 193-member General Assembly on Tuesday.

India was among the 157 nations that voted in favour, while eight member states – Argentina, Hungary, Israel, Micronesia, Nauru, Palau, Papua New Guinea, and the United States – voted against it.

Cameroon, Czech Republic, Ecuador, Georgia, Paraguay, Ukraine, and Uruguay abstained.

The resolution called for the "withdrawal of Israel from the Palestinian territory occupied since 1967, including East Jerusalem" and for the realisation of the inalienable rights of the Palestinian people, primarily the right to self-determination and the right to their independent state.

Through the resolution, the General Assembly reaffirmed its support, per international law, for the two-state solution of Israel and Palestine, living side by side in peace and security within recognised borders, based on the pre-1967 borders. It rejected any attempt at demographic change in the Gaza Strip. India also voted in fayour of a resolution that demanded that Israel withdraw from all the occupied Syrian Golan to the line of June 1967.



5.3 magnitude earthquake on Richter Scale that originated 40 km below ground in the Eturnagaram forest area of Telangana was felt in central and northern India at 7.27 a.m. The National Centre for Seismology (NCS) identified the location as 185km NNE of Nalgonda and 219km ENE of Hyderabad. Many citizens reported feeling the tremors for a few seconds. There were no reports of loss of life or damage to property.

"The epicentre of the earthquake is confined to the Godavari fault system and its vicinity where sev-





About <u>59 percent</u> of the land area of India is liable to seismic hazard damage





1. Body Waves

Primary waves (P-waves):

- The fastest type of seismic wave.
- Travel through solids, liquids, and gases.
- Cause particles in the medium to move back and forth in the same direction as the wave (longitudinal motion).

Secondary waves (S-waves):

- Slower than P-waves.
- Travel only through solids, not liquids or gases.
- Cause particles to move perpendicular to the wave's direction of travel (transverse motion).

2. Surface Waves

- Love waves (L-waves):
 - Move horizontally, side to side, perpendicular to the direction of wave travel.
 - Cause significant horizontal shearing of the ground, damaging structures.
- Rayleigh waves (R-waves):
 - Move in an elliptical, rolling motion similar to ocean waves.
 - Cause both vertical and horizontal ground motion.
 - Responsible for much of the shaking felt during earthquakes.



After anomaly alert, ISRO sets PROBA-3 launch for today

The mission was scheduled to launch at 4.08 p.m. on Wednesday; the 44.5-metre PSLV-C59 rocket will carry 550-kg satellites to their orbit

he PSLV-C59/PRO-BA-3 mission, initially scheduled for launch at 4.08 p.m. on Wednesday, has been rescheduled to 4.12 p.m. on Thursday after the detection of an anomaly.

At 3.19 p.m. the Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) announced on its official page on X: "Due to an anomaly detected in PROBA-3 spacecraft PSLV-C59/PROBA-3 launch rescheduled to tomorrow December 5, 2024 at 16.12 hours."

Key ISRO officials communicated the same to presspersons gathered at the launch venue.

Even at 3.08 p.m., the ISRO said the countdown had been progressing smoothly. "Countdown is progressing smoothly as PSLV-C59, an initiative led by NSIL and supported by ISRO's expertise, prepares

to launch ESA's PROBA-3 satellites into a highly elliptical orbit," it said.

Josef Aschbacher, Director-General of the European Space Agency, posted a message on social media saying: "During Proba3's pre-launch preparations at the Satish Dhawan Space Centre in India, an anomaly in the redundant propulsion system of the Coronagraph Spacecraft occurred. This propulsion system is part of the attitude and orbit control subsystem of the satellite and used to maintain orientation and pointing in space."

He further said: "The anomaly is currently under detailed investigation. The use of a software solution by the mission control team at European Space Agency's ESEC centre at Redu, Belgium is being evaluated to allow a launch on Thursday, December 5."

The PSLV-C59/Proba-3 Mission, the 61st flight of PSLV and the 26th using its XL configuration, is set to carry the ESA's PROBA-3 (Project for Onboard Autonomy) satellites into a highly elliptical orbit from the First Launch Pad (FLP), Satish Dhawan Space Centre (SDSC-SHAR), Sriharikota.

The 44.5-metre rocket will carry the 550-kg PRO-BA-3 satellites to their designated orbit in a mission lasting about 18 minutes.



Indo-Russian venture to set up 3 depots for Vande Bharat project

The Marathwada Rail Coach Factory in Latur, which has been taken over by the Indo-Russian joint venture Kinet for manufacturing Vande Bharat sleeper train sets, is currently undergoing equipment installation and will be equipped with a state-of-art assembly line, a top Kinet official stated.

Kinet has been established by the public sector Rail Vikas Nigam and Russian transportation company Transmashholding. The JV took over operational control of the Latur plant at the end of June. The plant commenced operational activities on September 3.

"The plant is currently undergoing equipment installation. It will be equipped with a state-of-the-art assembly line, including facilities such as body shop, storage, assembly, testing and trolley and paint shop. Hiring and

training for production staff are progressing to ensure operational readiness," TMH CEO Kirill Lipa told *The Hindu* in an interview.

Following Western sanctions due to the Russia-Ukraine War, Mr. Lipa said that India has emerged as a key hub for development and procurement of spare parts. "The supply chain team is collaborating closely with Indian suppliers to ensure the project's success. A number of contracts have been signed al-

ready," he said. For supply of brake and air-conditioning systems, TMH relies on China as a key supplier.

TMH is looking at supporting development of three depots, including the Latur factory, for indigenous manufacture of train sets in India. "TMH's expertise in manufacturing sleeper, seating and special-purpose coaches of various classes comes to mind as a potential perfect fit. The long-term intention is to build an industrial hub to manufacture components to meet the needs of both the Indian market and export to other BRICS countries," Mr. Lipa said.

While Kinet and Indian Railways are in the process of freezing design of the Vande Bharat Sleeper train sets, Mr. Lipa said the process of setting up production capacities is under way in parallel to design discussions.

Mr. Lipa said the total working capital which will be needed for upfront investment exceeds \$150 million, and the revenue will start rolling in for Kinet only after first prototypes are delivered next year.

According to tender requirements, Kinet is set to supply 1,920 Vande Bharat Sleeper coaches to Indian Railways, with first prototypes to be delivered within 24 months of the signing of contract in September last year. The project costs \$6.5 billion, including \$1.7 billion for manufacturing of rolling stock and \$4.8 billion for its maintenance over 35 years.



Notably, over 98% of the toll payments made in recent months were done through the FASTag technology. Chart I shows the State-wise amount of fees collected (in crores) across tolls since inception. With ₹32,510 crore collected, Uttar Pradesh is at the top. The Delhi-NCR region collected the least tolls at ₹263 crore.


Chart 2 shows the top four national highways where the most toll was collected since inception. The NH48, which runs from Delhi to Chennai, is listed first with a collection of ₹24,490 crore followed by NH44 (Srinagar to Kanniyakumari), NH16 (Kolkata to Chennai), and NH27 (Porbandar to Silchar).

Chart 3 shows the number of FASTags issued cumulatively (left axis) and the amount collected electronically in crores across all tolls (right axis), every month over time. Except for the dip during the pandemic months, the transaction value and the tags issued have surged since inception. As of October 2024, 10 crore tags have been issued. Map 4 shows the toll plazas which collected over \$100 crore electronically from April to October 2024. The Gharaunda toll plaza in Haryana collected ₹256 crore in the period, the most across the 1,040 tolls for which this data was available. The Shahjahanpur toll plaza in Rajasthan and the Bharthana in Gujarat, are second and third on the list.


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

INDIAN-ORIGIN SCOTTISH artist Jasleen Kaur has won the prestigious Turner Prize 2024 for her exhibition, "Alter Altar", that reflects on plurality, personal and political themes.

The jury — chaired by Alex Johnson and Delaine Le Bas. Farguharson, Director, Tate Britain - praised "the considered way in which Kaur weaves together the personal, political

and spiritual... choreographing a visual and aural experience that suggests both solidarity and joy". It also highlighted Kaur's "ability to gather different voices through unexpected and playful combinations of material".

At 38, Kaur was the youngest nominee for this year's award that includes a cash prize of £25,000. This year marks the 40th anniversary of the prize. The other shortlisted artists included Pio Abad, Claudette

Born in Glasgow, Kaur's great-grandfather reportedly moved from Punjab in 1950, three years after Partition; her fa-

ther owns a hardware store in Scotland, Her prize-winning exhibition "Alter Altar", first shown in Glasgow last year, also reflects on her own family history as migrants to Scotland and her upbringing.

It featured, among others, a vintage red Ford Escort covered with a huge crocheted doily, a reference to her father's migrant aspirations, worship bells, Irn-Bru orange resin, an Axminster carpet, and family photographs. Also playing were soundtracks that were part of Kaur's growing up years, from Nusrat Fateh Ali Khan to Bob Marley.

has often discussed her multicultural upbringing and influences. If her 2021 series, "Gut Feelings Meri Jaan", explored ideas around inheritance and belonging, history and archive, in the 2018 "I Keep Telling Them These Stories", she used archival footage and recordings gathered from India and Scotland to explore culture as praxis, family, identity and origins. Her 2019 publication, "Be Like Teflon". commissioned by Panel for Glasgow Women's Library, comprises conversations between Kaur and women of Indian heritage living in the UK.

Her website describes her as:

"An artist making with the slurry of life, Raised amidst betraval, secrecy and banished outsiders, her work is to make sense of what is out of view or withheld. She is called towards plurality, declassifications, polyphony, the blur. She is practising singing in the sediment till she is intoxicated."

In an interview on the Tate website, Kaur states: "There's this particular theory that I grew up with from the Sikh tradition which talks about Miri Piri. which is this balance of the political and the spiritual, I'm really interested in that duality and I've become guite obsessed with this

IndiGo ranked among worst airlines globally by AirHelp; airline refutes survey

INDIA'S LARGEST airline IndiGo has been listed among the world's worst airlines by European air passenger claims processing and facilitating agency AirHelp, which has ranked the airline at the 103rd spot out of a total of 109 airlines in the rankings. Reacting to the AirHelp rankings, IndiGo has refuted the survey and even questioned its credibility.

AirHelp releases an annual ranking of international airlines and airports. The rankings for airlines are based on three criteria — on-time performance, customer opinion, and processing of compensation claims. According to AirHelp, the three criteria contribute to the airline's score in equal measure, or 33.33 per cent each. In its 2024 report, AirHelp gave IndiGo a score of 4.80, placing it at the 103rd spot among 109 air-

lines in the list. The only other Indian airline on the list is Air India, which has been ranked 61 with a score of 6.15. Brussels Airlines has been ranked at the pole position, followed by Qatar Airways, and United Airlines with scores of 8.12, 8.11, and 8.04, respectively.

"India's aviation regulator DGCA(Directorate General of Civil Aviation), publishes data on airline punctuality and customer complaints monthly. IndiGo has consistently scored high on punctuality and has the lowest customer complaint ratio for an airline of its size and scale of operations. The

data published in the survey by AirHelp, an EU claim processing agency, does not report the sample size from India, and neither takes into account the methodology or compensation guidelines used by the global aviation industry — casting a doubt on its credibility," IndiGo said in a statement. "As India's most preferred airline, IndiGo refutes the findings of this survey and reiterates its promise of on-time, affordable, courteous and hassle-free travel experience for its customers," the airline added. **FULL REPORT ON**

PM internship scheme kicks off

TWO DAYS AFTER its planned launch, the PM internship scheme (PMIS) kicked off as interns from 656 districts started their internships with companies such as IOCL, ONGC, Vedanta, Maruti Suzuki, Titan, NTPC and others.

The ministry of corporate affairs (MCA) has also started the disbursement of ₹6,000 one-time grant under the direct benefit transfer (DBT) to the selected interns.

While the ministry didn't share the exact number of people who started their internships on Wednesday, the pilot project of the scheme aims to provide 1.25 lakh internship opportunities to people between 21-24 years of age. The interns will get a monthly stipend of ₹5000 for 12 months.

"The internships under PMIS aim to provide interns with hands-on experience and enhance the employability of India's youth," said an MCA statement.

While companies like ONGC are offering accommodation to interns travelling from different districts -along with training in soft skills and computer proficiency -- others like Maruti

Suzuki have designed a comprehensive 30-day induction programme.

Announced in the Budget 2024-25, PMIS aims to provide internship opportunities to 10 million people in top 500 companies over five years.

Recently, Chief Justice Sanjiv Khanna emphasised that "no voter should be turned down," indicating the court's commitment to ensuring accessible voting for all citizens.

Earlier, Election Commission of India (ECI) has pushed the maximum limit per polling station from 1,200 (in rural) and 1,400 (urban) to a uniform 1,500 voters, which has raised concerns regarding potential disenfranchisement.

- A petition challenged the ECI's decision, arguing that it would lead to overcrowded polling stations and longer wait times.
 - A voter takes around 90 seconds to cast their vote, allowing 45 voters per hour. Over 11 hours, a polling station can accommodate only 495 voters (660 voters with maximum efficiency).
 - The petition highlights that ECI's rationale for increasing the limit lacks fresh data like updated census.

- Rules for Setting up Polling Station:
- Representation of People Act, 1951 mandates the Election Commission to provide for a 'sufficient number of polling stations for every constituency'.
- A polling station should be located so that voters typically travel no more than 2 kilometers to vote, with exceptions for sparsely populated hilly or forest areas.
