





# Trudeau quits as party chief, to continue as PM for now



Canadian Prime Minister Justin Trudeau announced his resignation on Monday in the face of rising discontent over his leadership, and after the abrupt departure of his Finance Minister signaled growing turmoil within his government.

Mr. Trudeau said it had become clear to him that he cannot "be the leader during the next elections due to internal battles."

He planned to stay on as Prime Minister until a new leader of the Liberal Party is chosen.

"I don't easily back down faced with a fight, especially a very important one for our party and the country. But I do this job because the interests of Canadians and the well being of democracy is something that I hold dear," he said.

An official familiar with the matter said parliament, which had been due to resume on January 27, will be suspended until March 24. The timing will allow for a Liberal Party leadership race.

All three main opposition parties have said they plan to topple the Liberal Party in a no-confidence vote when parliament resumes, so a spring election to pick a permanent replacement was almost assured.

#### Announce 8th Pay Commission soon, trade unions tell FM

NEW DELHI

Ten Central Trade Unions (CTUs) in the Opposition camp and the Sangh Parivar-backed Bharatiya Mazdoor Sangh (BMS) have demanded the Centre constitute the eighth Pay Commission immediately.

The trade unions made the demand at a pre-Budget discussion with Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman here.

Senior BMS leader Pawan Kumar said they also demanded wage negotiations in public sector undertakings (PSUs) must begin immediately and income threshold for income tax raised to ₹10 lakh with existing exemptions.

"Pensioners must be made exempt from paying income tax on pensions," as per BMS memorandum.

The platform of 10 CTUs said in a statement after the meeting they demanded the Centre address the unemployment issue, fill up sanctioned vacant posts in PSUs and government departments, lift the ban on creating new posts, end outsourcing and contractualisation of jobs, increase in the number of days under MGNREGA to 200 with a wage increase to ₹600 per day and launch of a new urban employment guarantee policy.

"We demanded the Centre to rollback the policies of privatisation, disinvestment and sale of PSUs and government services to dearness allowance.

 Prime Minister will inaugurate the newly established Jammu Railway Division, fulfilling a long-standing demand for better rail management in India's northernmost region.



# **About Railway Division:**

What it is: A railway division is an administrative unit under Indian Railways, managing operations, maintenance, and infrastructure within its jurisdiction.

# **Organizational Hierarchy:**

- Indian Railways has 19 zones (including Metro Railway, Kolkata) and 70 divisions.
- Each zone is led by a General Manager (GM), while each division is headed by a Divisional Railway Manager (DRM).

### Jammu Railway Division:

 Zone: Jammu Division falls under the Northern Railway Zone, previously managed by the Firozpur Division.

### • Significance:

- 1. <u>Enhanced Connectivity:</u> Will oversee iconic projects like the *Anji Khad Bridge* (India's first cable-stayed rail bridge) and the *Chenab Rail Bridge* (world's highest railway arch).
- **2. <u>USBRL Project:</u>** Manages the Udhampur-Srinagar-Baramulla Railway Link, critical for connecting Kashmir to the rest of India.
- **3. <u>Strategic Importance:</u>** Boosts regional development, accessibility, and tourism in Jammu and Kashmir.
- **4. Modern Infrastructure:** Equipped with hi-tech facilities leveraging IT for efficient rail operations.

358th Birth Anniversary of Guru Gobind Singh





- Guru Gobind Singh was born on Paush Shukla Saptami in 1666 in Patna Sahib, Bihar.
- He was the **son of Guru Tegh Bahadur,** the ninth Sikh Guru, who was martyred by Mughal Emperor Aurangzeb.
  - He became the **tenth** and final Guru of the Sikhs at the age of 9 after his father's death.
- He Passed away in **1708** at the age of 41 following a battle with Mughal forces.

- Role in Shaping Sikhism and Its Principles
- He founded the Khalsa Panth in 1699 to create a spiritual and martial community.
  - The Khalsa identity is marked by five articles of faith: Kesh, Kara, Kanga, Kachera, and Kirpan.
- Sikh Literature: He was a poet, philosopher, and spiritual leader

He composed the **Dasam Granth**, a collection of hymns and poetry which covers topics of spirituality, ethics, and warfare.

He also compiled the **Zafarnama**, a letter to Emperor Aurangzeb, which is a unique blend of courage, philosophy, and dignity.

• Promotion of Equality and Unity: He advocated for the dismantling of caste and societal barriers. He also promoted the concept of Sarbat da Bhala (welfare for all), highlighting service to humanity as a key tenet of spiritual progress.



# CSIR Paracetamol Technology



 Union Minister Dr. Jitendra Singh has announced that the Council of Scientific and Industrial Research (CSIR) has developed an indigenous paracetamol drug, which would help reduce India's dependence on imported raw materials.

## Paracetamol:

• Paracetamol, chemically known as **N-acetyl-para-aminophenol**, is widely used for **pain relief and fever reduction**.

- In the United States and Japan, it is called acetaminophen (derived from its chemical structure), while most other countries, including India, use the name "paracetamol."
- It works by inhibiting prostaglandins, which amplify pain, and targets the hypothalamus for fever reduction.



• Risk and Threats: Paracetamol poisoning quietly causes thousands of deaths globally, with over 60,000 emergency visits and more than 500 deaths annually in the U.S. alone.

 The issue is underreported, especially in Asia, South America, and Africa, and is rarely discussed despite its scale.



# Decline in Rural Poverty: SBI Research



- Recently, SBI's economic research department (ERD) released a report on Rural Poverty.
- About Research: Findings
- India's poverty rate has dropped significantly from 22% in 2011-12 to below 5% in 2023-24, with minimal extreme poverty.
  - Rural poverty fell from 25.7% in 2011-12 to 4.86% in 2023-24, and urban poverty decreased from 4.6% in 2022-23 to 4.09% in 2023-24.

- Threshold: The report sets the new poverty line for FY24 at Rs 1,632 for rural areas and Rs 1,944 for urban areas, adjusted for inflation and the imputation factor.
  - Suresh Tendulkar's poverty line (estimated in 2011-12) was Rs 816 for rural areas and Rs 1,000 for urban areas.



- **Urban-Rural Consumption Disparity:** The gap in monthly per capita expenditure (MPCE) between rural and urban areas decreased to 70% in 2023-24 from 84% in 2011-12, reflecting sustained rural consumption growth.
- Impact of Inflation and Consumption: Rising inflation led to lower overall consumption, with a more pronounced effect in rural, lowincome states.
  - Middle-income states helped sustain consumption demand.

# ISRO's CROPS Experiment



• A batch of cowpea seeds which were taken into orbit by an Indian Space Research Organisation (ISRO) mission has unveiled their first leaves.

## About

• **CROPS payload:** The space agency sent eight cowpea seeds as part of the Compact Research Module for Orbital Plant Studies (CROPS) experiment.



- Aim: It is conducted by the Vikram Sarabhai Space Centre (VSSC) to study plant growth in microgravity conditions.
- **CROPS** is part of a larger initiative to evolve ISRO's capabilities in sustaining flora in extraterrestrial environments, with future phases expected to focus on **longer-term plant growth in space**.

# World Braille Day 2025


- January 4 is marked as World Braille Day.
- About
- Established: The day was adopted in 2018 by the United Nations General Assembly.
- The day is a tribute to Louis Braille who was born on January 04
   1809, the visionary behind the braille system.



## **Louis Braille**

who invented a system of reading and writing for visually impaired people was born on 4 January 1809

Braille used a system of raised dots to represent alphabets, words & numbers



Due to an eye injury he was left completely blind at the age of 3.

**Braille System:** It is used by both blind and partially sighted people worldwide to read books and periodicals.

• It was accepted by the Institute in Paris in 1854.

#### Significance:

- Braille is used in nearly every language worldwide.
- It is not only a means of communication but also a bridge to education, employment, and social inclusion for people who are blind or visually impaired.



- In Ms. X vs State of Karnataka Case, 2024, the Karnataka High Court (HC) held transgender people can change their name and gender on birth certificates.
- Changing the name and gender on birth certificates of transgenders is explicitly permitted under the Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act, 2019 and Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Rules, 2020.

What are the Key Facts of the Ms. X vs State of Karnataka Case, 2024?

Background: The petitioner was diagnosed with gender dysphoria and she underwent sex-reassignment surgery and legally changed her name and gender identity on her Aadhaar card, driving license, and passport.

However, her request to **change** the gender and name on her **birth certificate was rejected.** 

Gender dysphoria refers to **psychological distress** that occurs when a person's sex assigned at birth does not match his gender identity.

Legal Objection: Section 15 of the Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 permits changes to birth certificates only if the information is erroneous or was entered fraudulently or incorrectly.

Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 governs the granting of birth and death certificates.

Violation of Fundamental Rights:

The petitioner argued that the restrictive nature of Section 15 of Registration of Births and Deaths Act, 1969 violated her right to life with dignity under Article 21 of the Indian Constitution.

She also claimed that documents showing different identities create a dual identity, leading to potential harassment and discrimination.


- Transgender Persons (Protection of Rights) Act, 2019: It states that transgender people can be issued a "certificate of identity" as proof of their identity (Section 6) which can be revised if they choose to opt for a sex-reassignment surgery (Section 7).
  - The law explicitly says the gender of a transgender person "shall be recorded in all official documents" per this certificate.



- Recently, Uttarakhand has launched the Winter Char Dham circuit to promote year-round tourism and attract visitors to the state during the off-season winter months.
- Char Dham shrines (4 revered shrines) are four holy sites i.e., Yamunotri, Gangotri, Kedarnath and Badrinath and are located in the Garhwal Himalayas. They are traditionally visited between May and November.







- During the winter months, the presiding deities of these temples are brought to shrines at lower altitudes at:
  - Kedarnath: Omkareshwar Temple in Ukhimath (Rudraprayag)
  - Badrinath: Pandukeshwar in Chamoli.
  - Gangotri: Mukhba in Uttarkashi
  - Yamunotri: Kharsali in Uttarkashi

 Adi Shankaracharya (exponent of the Advaita Vedanta) established the Char Dhams in four different directions of the country which include Badrinath, Puri, Dwarka and Rameshwaram.
